- Now, **make a time table**. Try to mention the topics that have to be studied in 24 hours. You can also mention the monthly target here.
- Choose the **best books available in the market**. Try not to refer to a lot of books for preparation. Stick to 2-3 books and you are good to go.
- **Read the newspapers daily** to know what is happening around you. Try to maintain consistency when it comes to reading the newspaper.

- **Brush up your vocabulary** to know about new words and their meanings.
- Solve **2-3 mock tests** while the preparation is going on. This will enable you to know at what speed you have to solve questions to complete the examination.

## **About KLEE 2022**

Kerala Law Entrance Examination (KLEE) is a computer-based examination that is held for the admission into 3 year LLB, 5 Year Integrated LLB and LLM courses. In the examination of all the 3 subjects, 200 multiple-choice questions are asked. There is a negative marking of 01 marks in case of wrong answers. The candidates who qualify the entrance test are granted admission in Government / Self Financing Law Colleges of Kerala.
