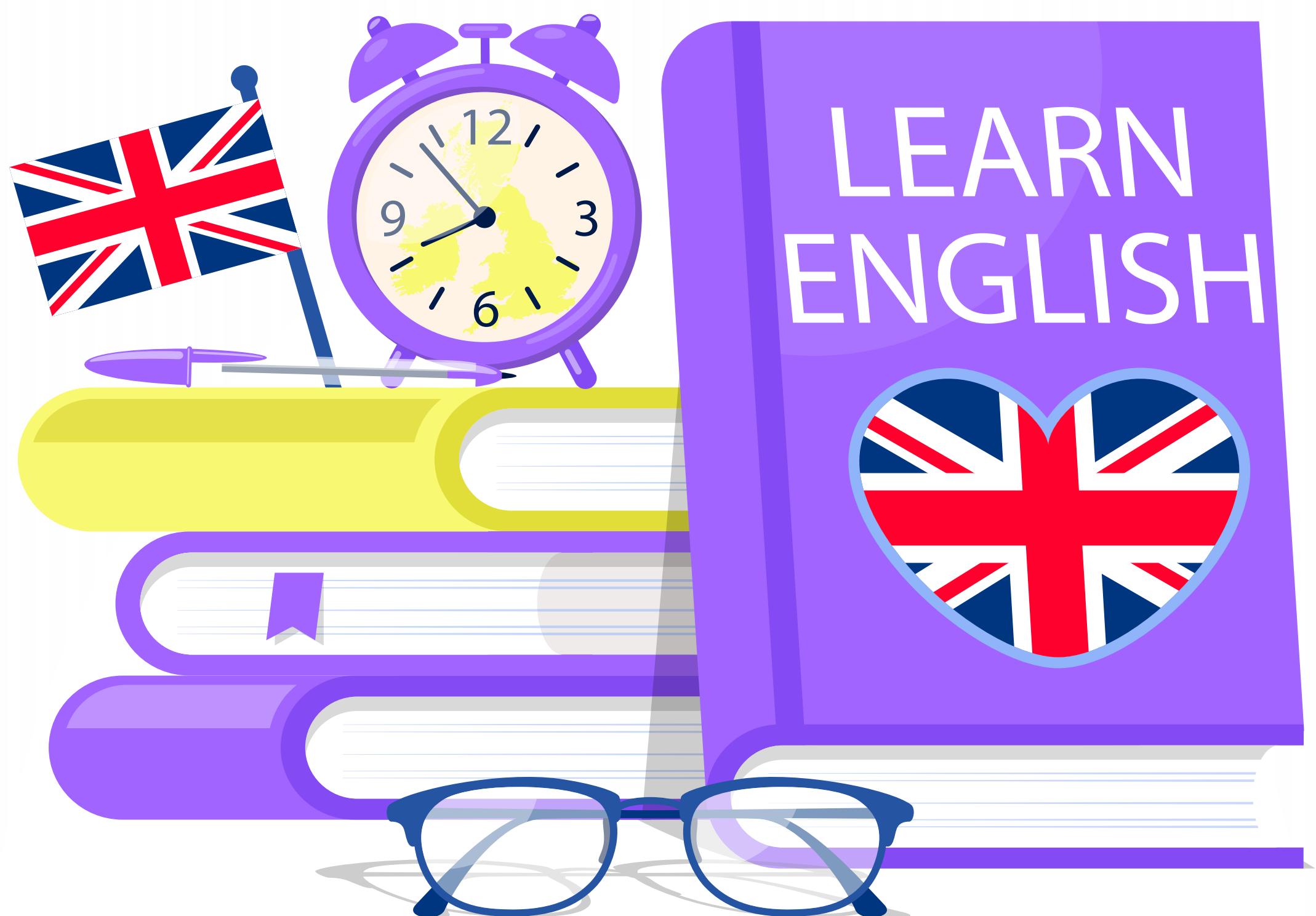


# BRITISH

## ENGLISH PHRASES



## Bob's your uncle

**Meaning:** Used to emphasize that something is straightforward or easy.

**Example:** Just follow the recipe, add the ingredients, and Bob's your uncle - you have a delicious meal!

## Chinwag

**Meaning:** A casual and friendly conversation or chat.

**Example:** Let's have a chinwag over a cup of tea.

## Gobsmacked

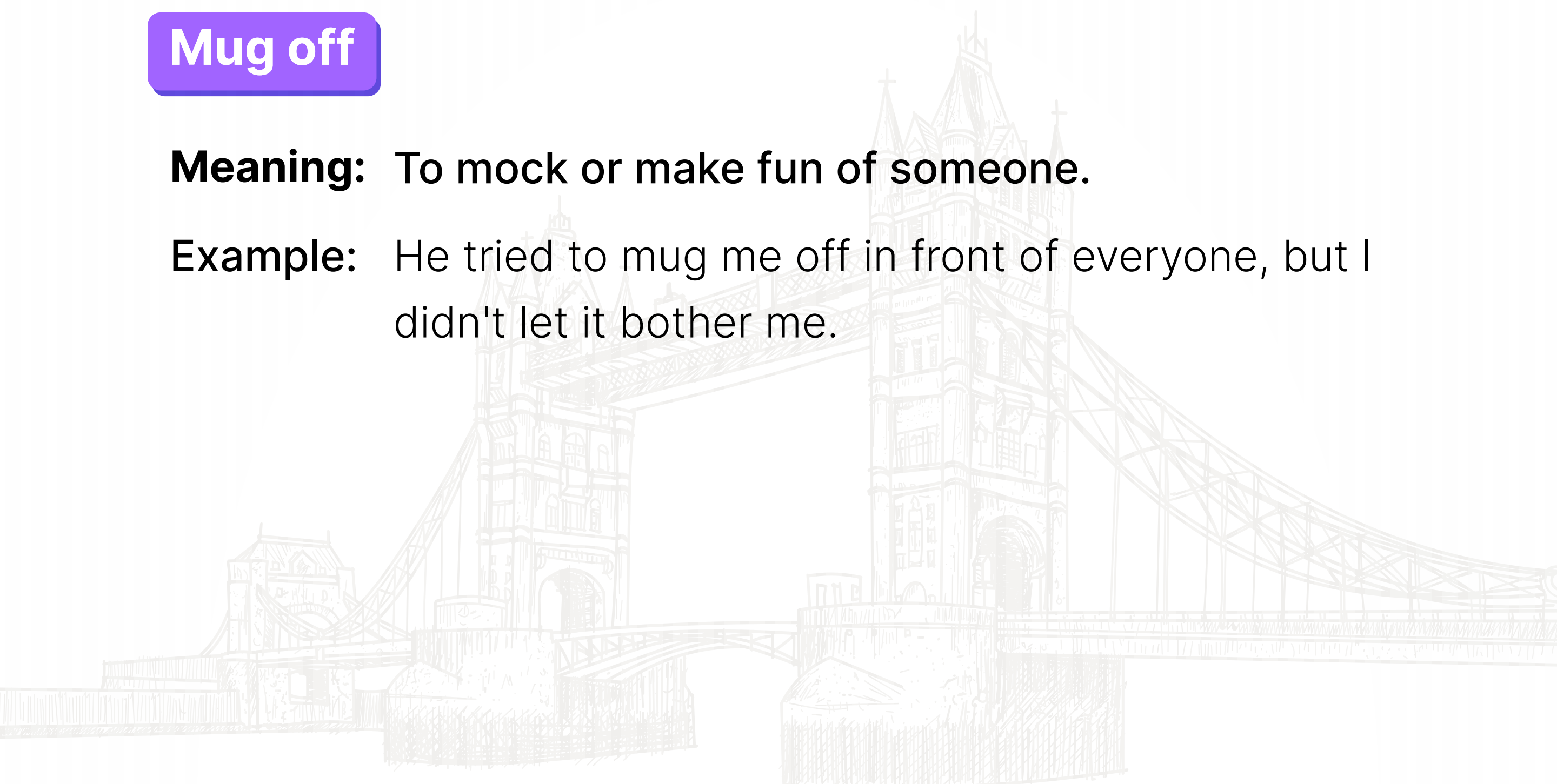
**Meaning:** Extremely surprised or shocked.

**Example:** I was absolutely gobsmacked when I heard the news.

## Mug off

**Meaning:** To mock or make fun of someone.

**Example:** He tried to mug me off in front of everyone, but I didn't let it bother me.



## Taking the mickey

**Meaning:** Teasing or making fun of someone, often in a lighthearted way.

**Example:** I was just taking the mickey; I didn't mean to offend you.

## Sorted

**Meaning:** Everything is in order or organized.

**Example:** The documents are all sorted and ready for the meeting.

## Tosh

**Meaning:** Nonsense or something that is not true.

**Example:** What he said is complete tosh; don't believe him.

## Legless

**Meaning:** Extremely drunk or intoxicated.

**Example:** After all those shots, he was completely legless.

## Bants

**Meaning:** Short for "banter," which refers to friendly and playful teasing or joking.

**Example:** We were just having a bit of bants; no harm intended.

## Blimey

**Meaning:** An exclamation of surprise or amazement.

**Example:** Blimey, that was a close call!

## Chuffed

**Meaning:** Delighted or pleased about something.

**Example:** I'm absolutely chuffed with my exam results.

## Doddle

**Meaning:** Something that is very easy or straightforward to do.

**Example:** The project was a doddle; I finished it in no time.

## Gutted

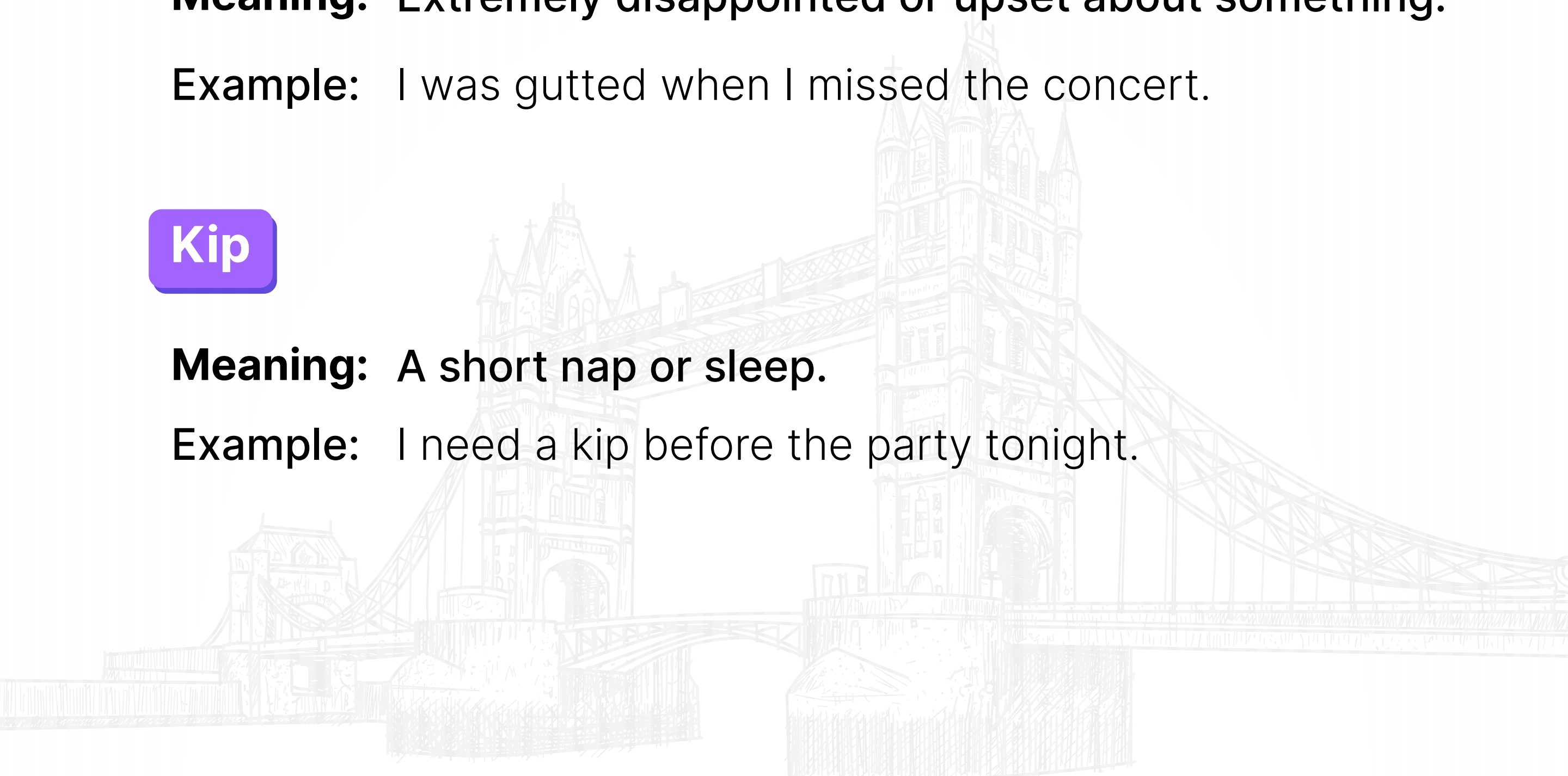
**Meaning:** Extremely disappointed or upset about something.

**Example:** I was gutted when I missed the concert.

## Kip

**Meaning:** A short nap or sleep.

**Example:** I need a kip before the party tonight.





## Miffed

**Meaning:** Annoyed or slightly upset.

**Example:** I was a bit miffed when they canceled our plans.

## Nosh

**Meaning:** Food or a meal, especially something tasty.

**Example:** Let's grab some nosh at the new restaurant.

## Skive

**Meaning:** To avoid work or responsibilities, often by pretending to be sick.

**Example:** He's always trying to skive off work early.

## Sod's law

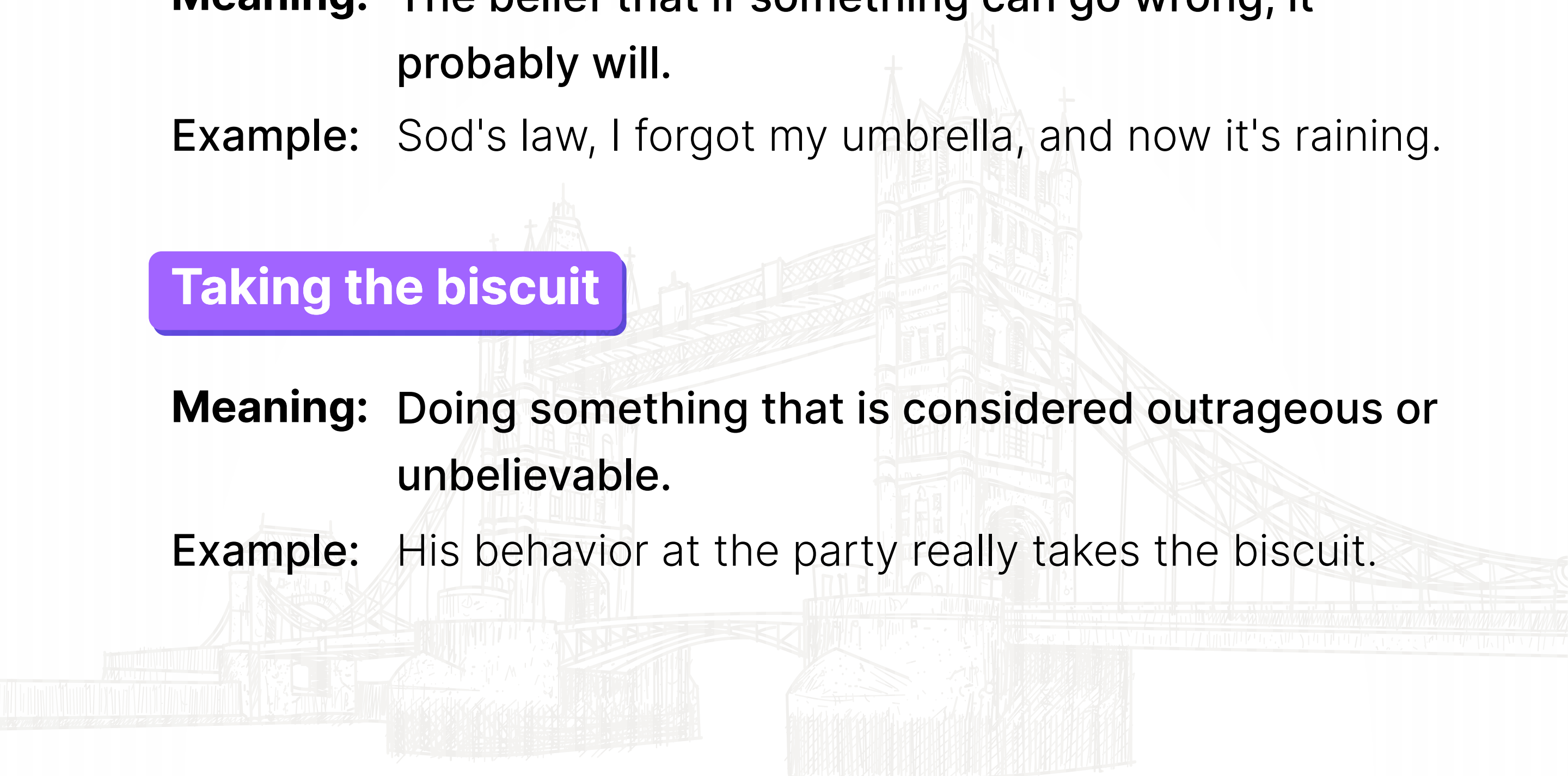
**Meaning:** The belief that if something can go wrong, it probably will.

**Example:** Sod's law, I forgot my umbrella, and now it's raining.

## Taking the biscuit

**Meaning:** Doing something that is considered outrageous or unbelievable.

## Wazzock

**Meaning:** A derogatory term for someone considered foolish or annoying.

**Example:** He's such a wazzock; I can't stand him.

## A cheeky one

**Meaning:** Refers to having an alcoholic drink, often secretly or without permission.

**Example:** Let's grab a cheeky one after work.

## Cuppa

**Meaning:** A cup of tea or coffee.

## Donkey's years

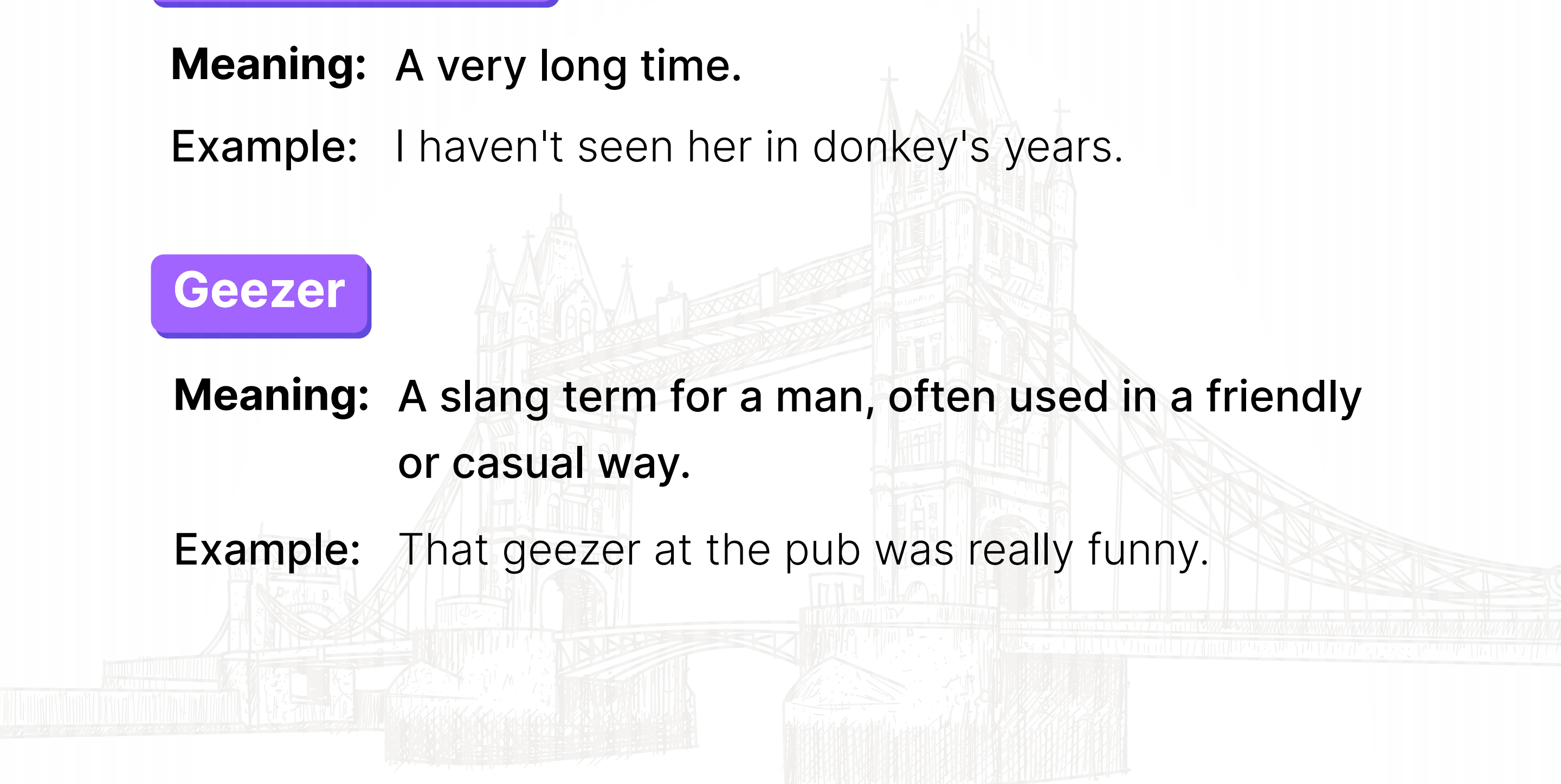
**Meaning:** A very long time.

## Tickety-boo

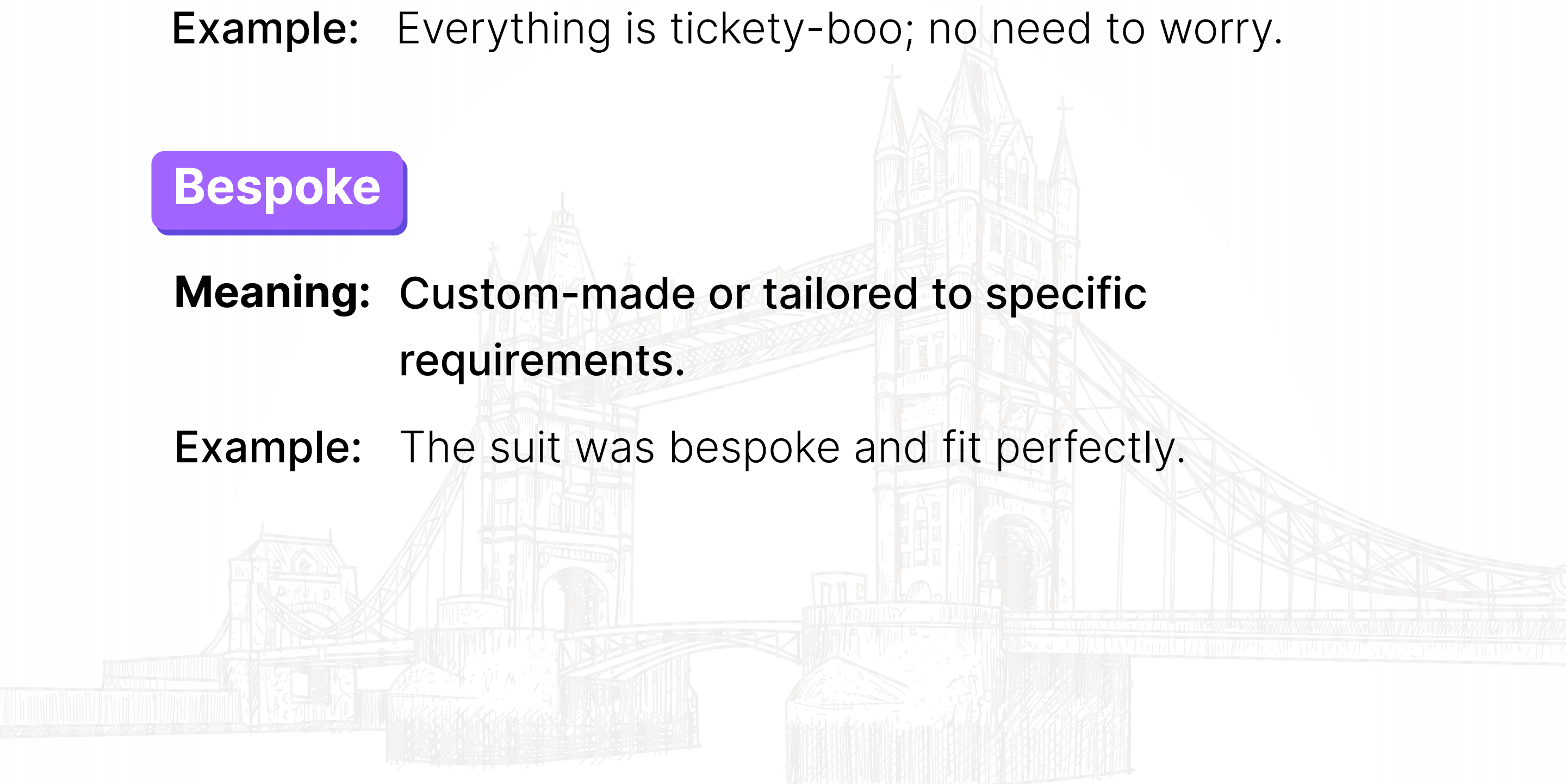
**Meaning:** Going well or in good order.

## Chinny reckon

**Meaning:** Expressing doubt or skepticism about someone's claim.

## Faff

**Meaning:** To waste time or procrastinate.

**Example:** Stop faffing around and get to work!

## Gobby

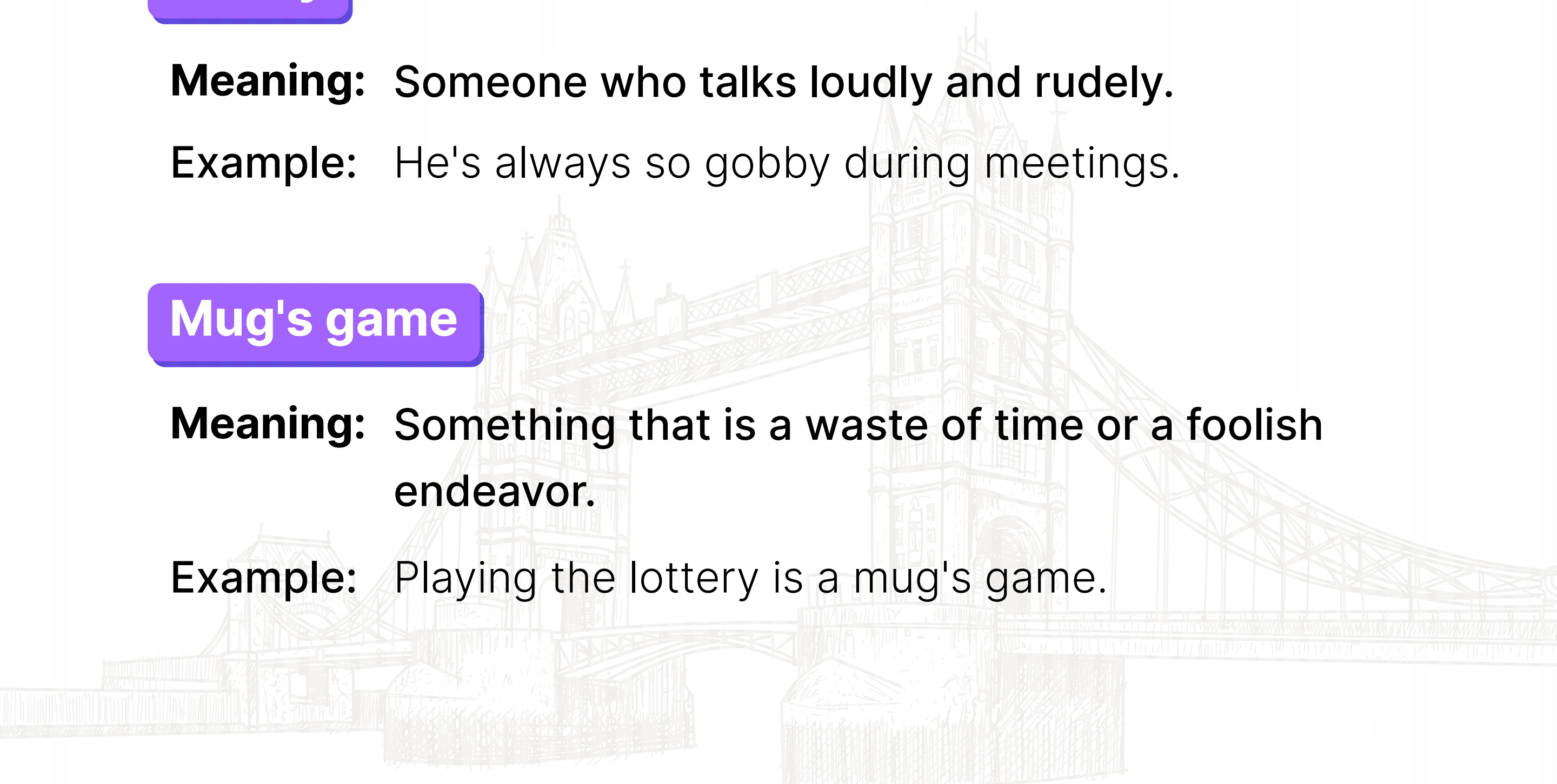
**Meaning:** Someone who talks loudly and rudely.

## Mug's game

## Nutter

## Taking the mick

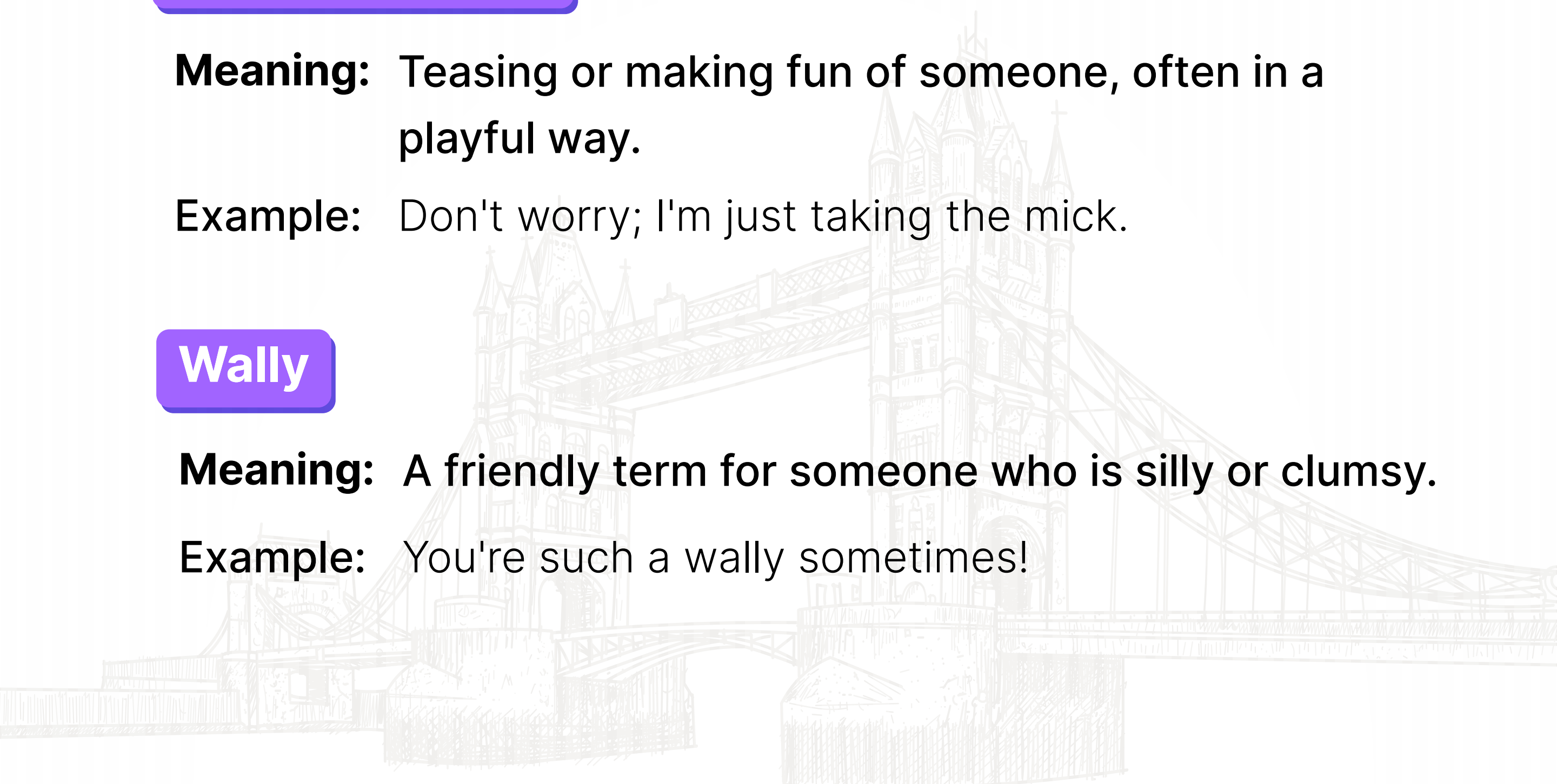
**Meaning:** Teasing or making fun of someone, often in a playful way.

## Knackered

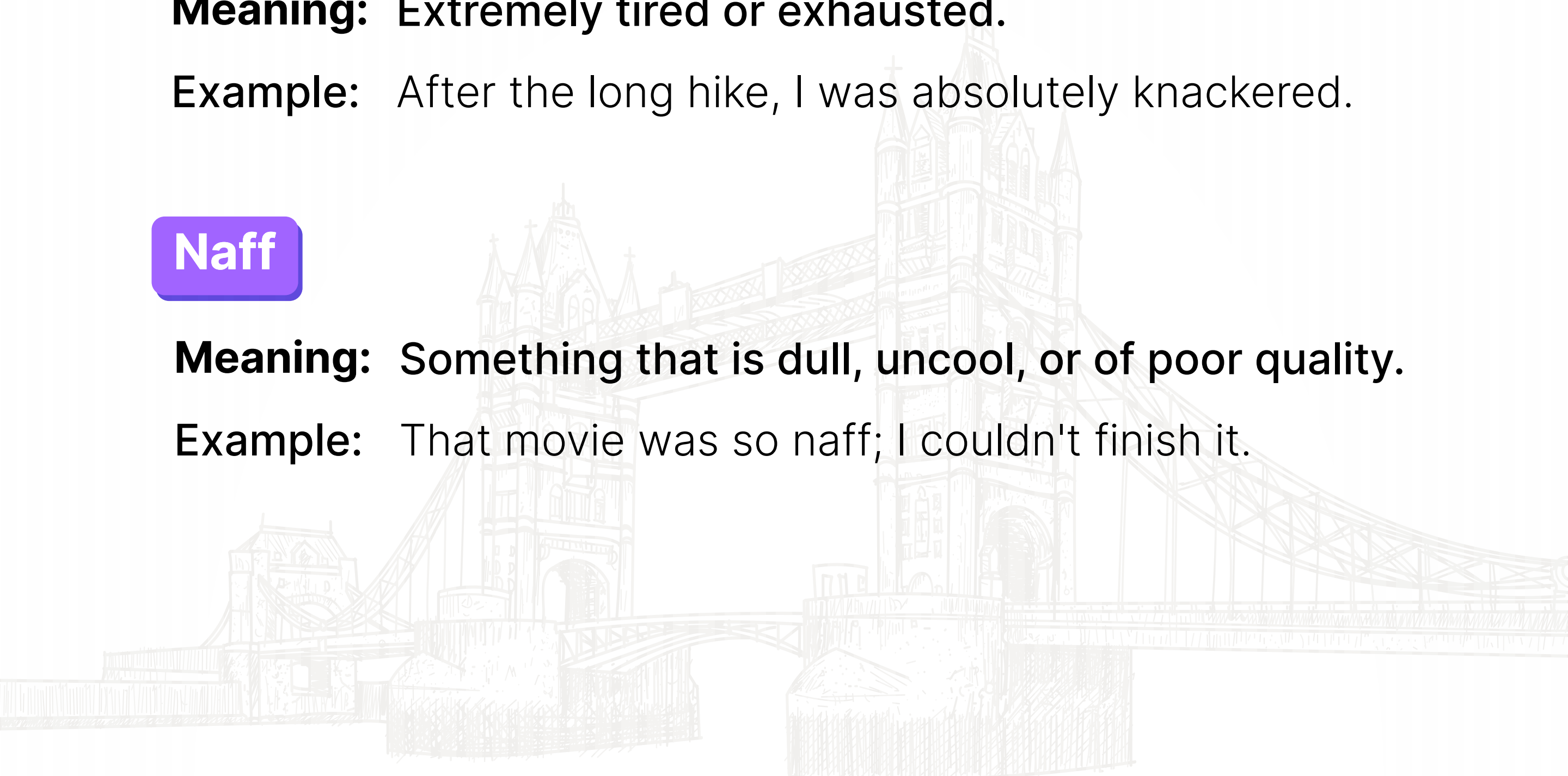
**Meaning:** Extremely tired or exhausted.

## All mouth and no trousers

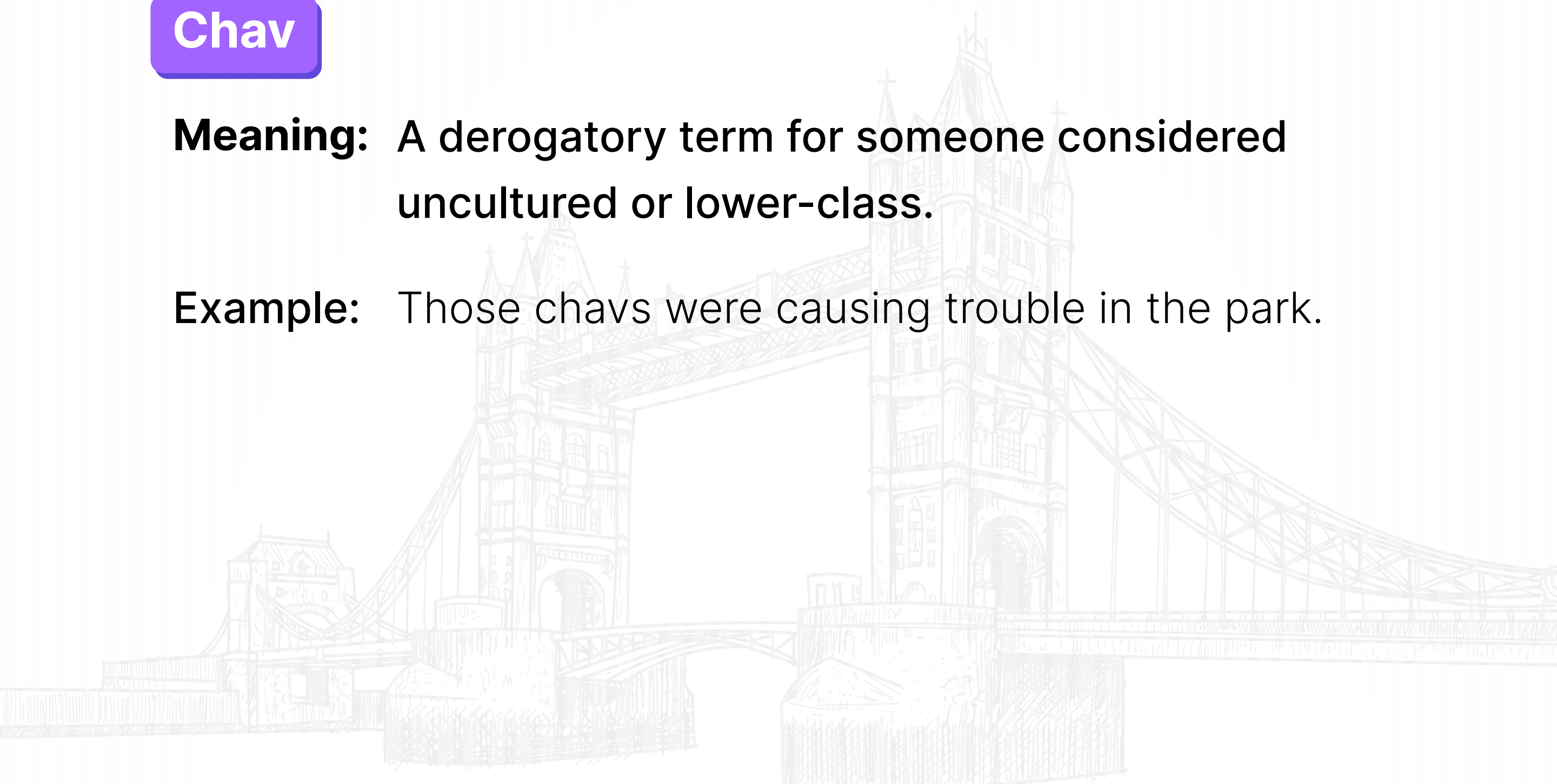
**Meaning:** Someone who talks confidently but doesn't follow through with actions.
