

### **Solution**

**Solution**

On 5 January 2018, the Reserve Bank of India announced, a new redesigned ₹10 banknote.

### Design:-

- The Reserve Bank of India issued ₹10 denomination banknotes in the Mahatma Gandhi (New) Series with motif of Sun Temple, Konark on the reverse, depicting the country's cultural heritage.
- The base colour of the note is Chocolate brown. Dimension of the banknote will be 123 mm × 63 mm.

### Security features :-

The security features seen on the new Mahatma Gandhi series 10 rupee note are:

- Portrait of Mahatma Gandhi at the centre
- Micro letters 'RBI', 'भारत', 'INDIA' and '10'
- Windowed demetalised security thread with inscriptions 'भारत' and RBI
- Ashoka Pillar emblem on the right
- Mahatma Gandhi portrait and electrotype 10 Watermark
- Number panel with numerals growing from small to big on the top left side and bottom right side.
- Year of printing of the note on the left.

### Solution

- **Punjab National Bank (PNB) and National Scheduled Castes Finance and Development Corporation (NSFDC)** have tied up to provide financial assistance for economic empowerment of persons belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC) families living below Double Poverty Line (DPL).
- A Memorandum of Agreement to this effect was signed by B.M.Padha, Corporate General Manager , Priority Sector &

Financial Inclusion Division, PNB and Devanand, General Manager, NSFDC.

- Under this tie-up, PNB would act as a channelising agent for the loan schemes of NSFDC.
- Concessional finance and skill training grants would be provided to unemployed SC persons living below Double Poverty Line, according to a PNB release.

### Solution

- In intraday trade, the stock touched a fresh record high of Rs1,53.75 on the BSE, up 3.31% from its previous close. Tata Consultancy Services Ltd (TCS) and Reliance Industries Ltd (RIL) are the other two companies which crossed market capitalisation of Rs5 trillion.
