Solution

- The Kalidas Samman is a prestigious arts award presented annually by the government of **Madhya Pradesh** in India.
- The award is named after Kālidāsa, a renowned Classical Sanskrit writer of ancient India.
- The Kalidas Samman was first awarded in 1980.
- It was initially conferred in alternate years in the fields of *Classical Music, Classical Dance, Theatre and Plastic Arts*.
- From 1986-87 onwards, the awards were presented in all four fields every year.

- The award is presented for outstanding achievement in one of the four categories.

Solution

- RBI amended the Banking Ombudsman Scheme in which it has allowed the banking ombudsman to impose a fine of up to **Rs20 lakh** on banks for mis-selling of third party products such as insurance and mutual funds.
- So far, banking ombudsmen were allowed to impose a fine of *Rs10 lakh* on banks for mis-selling.

Solution

- The Mahabodhi Temple Complex, Bodh Gaya lies 115 km south of the state capital of **Bihar**, Patna and 16 km from the district headquarters at Gaya, in Eastern India.
- It is one of the four holy sites related to the life of the Lord Buddha, and particularly to the attainment of Enlightenment.
- In June 2002, the Mahabodhi Temple became a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
