

• Innovative features include use of rainwater for toilets and irrigation; heat recuperation from refrigerators to produce hot water; a CHF 1 million solar parc from Romande Energie Renouvelable that also provides energy back to the Swiss electricity grid; energy efficient lighting; local and recycled building materials; geothermal heating and a decentralised carbon dioxide controlled air supply system.

Along with the foremost heritage Indo-Islamic monuments of the 15th to 17th centuries, there are potential heritage precincts in the form of the Pols, the traditional residential clusters of the medieval period, which makes Ahmedabad exceptional. Combining these all, the historic walled city of Ahmedabad has it all to be the first city in India to be inscribed in UNESCO's World Heritage City list of 2017.

• Historic City of Ahmedabad: Situated in the heart of Gujarat, Ahmedabad has a character like no other, defined by a spirit of enterprise. Although Ahmedabad is a bustling metropoliton with reputed institutes and a rapidly growing economy, it is also deeply rooted in tradition. The city if known for its association with Mahatma Gandhi and in addition to a complex maze of neighbourhood called pols, hosts some of the country's finest medieval Islamic Architecture.

- Mithali, who has represented India in 89 T20Is, announced her retirement from the shortest format back in September 2019. Mithali

has 17 half-centuries in T20Is with a top score of 97 not out.

- The integrated mobile app will cater to other passenger needs like booking porter, retiring room, ordering food besides train tickets. The app has been developed by the CRIS (Centre for Railway Information Systems), the Railways' software arm.
