The given word "Suggestion" seems to be a synonym as it means an idea or plan put forward for consideration.


The other given word "Refuse" seems to be its antonym as it means to indicate or show that one is not willing to do something.

4. SECULARISM

- 1. Secularism in India means equal treatment of all religions by the state. With the 42nd Amendment of the Constitution of India enacted in 1976, the Preamble to the Constitution asserted that India is a secular nation.
- 2. Secularism in India means having a country with distinct religions and cultures that do not separate religion from civic affairs and state. It describes different religions in different states of India which emphasize more the separation of religion.
- 3. Secularism refers to the separation of religion from the state. It means that the state should not discriminate among its citizens on the basis of religion. It should neither encourage nor discourage the followers of any religion. It shifts the focus from religion towards "temporal" and material concerns. Enlightenment philosophers promoted secularism.

5. DEMONETISATION

- 1. It is a situation where the Central Bank of the country (Reserve Bank in India) withdraws the old currency notes of the certain denomination as an official mode of payment.
- 2. On November 8, 2016, Prime Minister Narendra Modi in a surprise announcement said the existing higher denomination currency (Rs 500 and Rs 1000) will cease to be legal tenders. PM said this is the government's biggest push to fight black money and end corruption. The opposition, however, criticised the government for poor implementation of the scheme and said a lot of people have died standing in queues trying to get their hands on the new currency. The government also introduced new Rs 500 and Rs 2000 notes and urged people to move towards a cashless economy. But the opposition has been protesting the government's decision, even stalling Parliament. A 'Jan Aakrosh Diwas' was observed by Left and other major parties.
- 3. Chaos ensued in the cash-dependent economy (some 78 per cent of all Indian customer transactions are in cash), as long, snaking lines formed outside ATMs and banks, which had to shut down for a day. The new rupee notes have different specifications, including size and thickness, requiring re-calibration of ATMs: only 60 per cent of the country's 200,000 ATMs were operational. Even those dispensing bills of lower denominations

faced shortages. The government's restriction on daily withdrawal amounts added to the misery, though a waiver on transaction fees did help a bit.

- 1. According to the Constitution of North Korea, the country is a democratic republic and the Supreme People's Assembly (SPA) and Provincial People's Assemblies (PPA) are elected by direct universal suffrage and secret ballot. Suffrage is guaranteed to all citizens aged 17 and over. In reality, these elections are for show and feature single-candidate races only.
- 2. When Saudi Arabia held municipal elections in the 50s and 60s, women were not allowed to vote or stand for office. No further elections were held until 2005. Despite some expectation that women would be allowed to participate on that occasion, Saudi officials decided that they would not.
- 3. In 17th century England, there was renewed interest in Magna Carta. The Parliament of England passed the Petition of Right in 1628 which established certain liberties for subjects. The English Civil War was fought between the King and an oligarchic but elected Parliament, during which the idea of a political party took form with groups debating rights to political representation during the Putney Debates of 1647.

- 1. The UN and the nuclear age were born almost simultaneously.

 The horror of the Second World War, culminating in the nuclear blasts at Hiroshima and Nagasaki, brought home the need to address the nuclear issue.
- 2. By its first resolution, the General Assembly established the UN Atomic Energy Commission to deal with the problems raised by the discovery of atomic energy. And a landmark address by United States President Dwight D. Eisenhower in 1953, "Atoms for Peace", led to the establishment in 1957 of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA). The International Atomic Energy Agency works with its Member States and multiple partners worldwide to promote the safe, secure and peaceful use of nuclear technologies.
- 3. IAEA's relationship with the United Nations is guided by an agreement signed in 1957. It stipulates that: "The Agency undertakes to conduct its activities in accordance with the Purposes and Principles of the United Nations Charter to promote peace and international co-operation, and in conformity with policies of the United Nations furthering the establishment of safeguarded worldwide disarmament and in conformity with any international agreements entered into pursuant to such policies."

- 2. The constitution declares India a sovereign, socialist, secular democratic republic, assuring its citizen's justice, equality and liberty, and endeavors to promote fraternity. The original 1950 constitution is preserved in a helium-filled case at the Parliament House in New Delhi. The words "secular" and "socialist" were added to the preamble in 1976 during the Emergency.
