Delhi Cantonment Board will conduct written Examination for the post of Junior Clerk as per examination scheme given below:

Written Exam:

- (v) **General Awareness:** Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's General Awareness of the environment around him/her and its application to society. The questions will be designed to test knowledge of Current Events and of such matter of everyday observation as may be expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to History, Polity, Constitution, Sports, Art & Culture, Geography, Economics, Everyday Science, Scientific research, National/International Organizations/Institutions etc.
- (vi) **General Intelligence & Reasoning Ability:** The syllabus of General Intelligence & Reasoning Ability includes questions of both verbal and non-verbal types. Test may include questions on analogies, similarities, differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgement, decision making, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship, concepts, arithmetical reasoning, verbal and figure classification, arithmetical number series etc.
- (vii) **Arithmetical & Numerical Ability:** The test of Arithmetical and Numerical Abilities will cover Number Systems including questions on simplification, Decimals, Data Interpretation, Fractions, L.C.M., H.C.F. Ratio & Proportion, Percentage, Average, Profit & Loss, Discount, Simple & Compound Interest, Menstruation, Time & Work, Time & Distance, Table & Graphs etc.
- (viii) **English Language & Comprehension:** Testing of candidate's understanding and comprehension of the English Language. In addition to this, questions on its Vocabulary, Grammar, Sentence Structure, Synonyms, Antonyms and its correct usage etc. would also be covered.

However, the Competent Authority reserves the Right to Change/Amend the examination Scheme, if so, required, anytime before the examination.
