



# VOCABULARY AIRORPORT



# Airport

**Meaning:** A facility for the arrival, departure, and maintenance of aircraft.

**Example:** We arrived at the airport two hours before our flight.

#### **Terminal**

**Meaning:** A building at the airport where passengers board and disembark from aircraft.

Example: Our gate is in Terminal A.

#### Runway

**Meaning:** A long, paved strip for takeoff and landing of aircraft.

**Example:** The airplane taxied to the runway before taking off.

#### Aircraft

Meaning: Any vehicle designed for air travel, such as airplanes and helicopters.

**Example:** The aircraft was equipped with modern navigation systems.

#### Arrival

**Meaning:** The act of reaching or coming to a destination, often referring to flights.

Example: The flight's arrival was delayed by an hour.

# Boarding

**Meaning:** The process of passengers getting on an aircraft before a flight.

Example: Boarding for Flight 123 is now complete.

# Baggage

**Meaning:** Personal belongings and luggage carried by passengers.

**Example:** Don't forget to pick up your baggage from the carousel.

# Security

**Meaning:** Measures and procedures in place to ensure safety at the airport.

**Example:** Passengers must go through security screening before boarding.

#### Customs

**Meaning:** Officials who inspect and control the movement of goods and people at international borders.

**Example:** You need to declare your purchases at customs.

#### **Immigration**

**Meaning:** The process of entering and staying in a foreign country.

**Example:** Passengers must go through immigration upon arrival.

#### Gate

**Meaning:** The designated area at the airport from which passengers board their flights.

Example: Our flight is departing from Gate 15.

#### Ticket

Meaning: A document that grants admission or passage, often for a flight.

Example: Please have your ticket and ID ready for inspection.

# Passport

**Meaning:** An official document issued by a government, used for international travel.

**Example:** You'll need your passport to travel abroad.

#### Visa

Meaning: An official authorization or endorsement in a passport allowing entry into a foreign country.

**Example:** She applied for a tourist visa to visit France.

# Luggage Cart

**Meaning:** A wheeled cart used to transport baggage within the airport.

Example: I grabbed a luggage cart to help carry our bags.

#### TSA (Transportation Security Administration)

**Meaning:** A U.S. government agency responsible for airport security.

Example: TSA agents conduct security checks at airports.

#### Jet Bridge

**Meaning:** An enclosed, movable bridge for passengers to board and disembark from an aircraft.

**Example:** Passengers walked through the jet bridge to enter the plane.

#### Airlines

Meaning: Companies that provide air transport services.

Example: Delta and United are popular airlines.

# Delay

**Meaning:** A situation in which a flight does not depart or arrive on time.

**Example:** The flight experienced a two-hour delay due to weather.

#### Pilot

**Meaning:** The person who operates and controls an aircraft during a flight.

**Example:** The pilot announced our descent into the destination city.

# Flight Attendant

Meaning: Crew members responsible for passenger safety and comfort during a flight.

**Example:** The flight attendant offered snacks and beverages.

# Baggage Claim

Meaning: An area where passengers retrieve their checked luggage after a flight.

Example: Let's head to baggage claim to pick up our bags.

#### Air Traffic Control (ATC)

**Meaning:** A service that manages and monitors aircraft movements in the airspace.

**Example:** The air traffic controller directed the plane for landing.

#### Aerobridge

**Meaning:** A jet bridge that connects the airport terminal directly to the aircraft.

**Example:** Passengers walked through the aerobridge to board the plane.

#### Cabin

Meaning: The enclosed interior of an aircraft where passengers sit during a flight.

**Example:** Please return to your seats; we are preparing for cabin crew service.

#### Frequent Flyer

**Meaning:** A traveler who accumulates miles or points for flying with a particular airline.

Example: As a frequent flyer, he enjoys special privileges.

# Baggage Check

**Meaning:** The process of submitting luggage for inspection and loading onto the aircraft.

**Example:** We need to go to baggage check before proceeding to security.

# ATM (Automated Teller Machine)

**Meaning:** A machine that dispenses cash, often found in airport terminals.

**Example:** I'll withdraw some cash from the airport ATM.

#### Lost and Found

**Meaning:** A service for reporting and recovering lost items at the airport.

**Example:** I left my laptop on the plane and had to visit the lost and found office.

# VIP Lounge

Meaning: An exclusive area at the airport for premium passengers and frequent flyers.

**Example:** He enjoyed complimentary drinks and snacks in the VIP lounge.

# In-flight

Meaning: Activities, services, or conditions that occur during a flight.

**Example:** The in-flight entertainment included movies and music.

# Direct Flight

**Meaning:** A flight that travels nonstop to the destination without layovers.

Example: We booked a direct flight from New York to London.

# **Connecting Flight**

**Meaning:** A flight with a layover or stop at an intermediate airport before reaching the final destination.

Example: Our connecting flight to Paris departs in two hours.

#### **Control Tower**

Meaning: A tall structure at the airport from which air traffic controllers monitor and manage aircraft movements.

**Example:** The control tower cleared the plane for takeoff.

#### **Duty-Free Shop**

Meaning: A store at the airport where travelers can purchase goods without paying certain taxes.

**Example:** She bought some perfume at the duty-free shop.

#### Airline Ticket Counter

Meaning: The area where passengers check in and receive their boarding passes.

Example: We need to go to the airline ticket counter to check in.

# Baggage Tag

**Meaning:** A label attached to luggage indicating the owner and destination.

Example: Make sure your baggage tag matches your flight.

#### Escalator

Meaning: A moving staircase used for passengers to ascend or descend between airport levels.

Example: We took the escalator down to the baggage claim area.

#### Car Rental

**Meaning:** A service at the airport that allows passengers to rent vehicles.

Example: We reserved a car rental for our trip.

## **Airport Shuttle**

Meaning: A transportation service that transfers passengers between the airport and nearby locations.

**Example:** The airport shuttle will take us to the hotel.

#### Lost Luggage

Meaning: Luggage that has been misplaced or is missing during travel.

**Example:** The airline is working to locate the lost luggage.

#### **Security Check**

**Meaning:** The process of screening passengers and their belongings before entering the secure area of the airport.

Example: All passengers must go through security check.

#### **Ground Crew**

Meaning: Workers responsible for handling aircraft on the ground, including loading and unloading baggage.

**Example:** The ground crew is preparing the plane for departure.

## Baggage Handler

**Meaning:** An airport worker responsible for loading and unloading luggage onto aircraft.

**Example:** The baggage handler carefully placed the suitcases on the conveyor belt.

# Flight Information Display

**Meaning:** Electronic screens displaying flight departure and arrival information.

**Example:** Check the flight information display for updates on your departure time.

#### **Check-in Counter**

Meaning: The area where passengers provide their identification and receive their boarding passes.

**Example:** Please proceed to the check-in counter to complete your registration.

#### **Aircraft Maintenance**

**Meaning:** The routine inspection and repair of aircraft to ensure safe operation.

**Example:** The aircraft maintenance team is conducting engine checks.

#### **Ground Transportation**

**Meaning:** Transportation options available for passengers to travel between the airport and other destinations.

**Example:** There are various ground transportation options, including taxis and buses
