Eminent industrialist and former chairman of Tata Sons who passed away in October 2024

Ratan Tata

- He was born on December 28, 1937 in Mumbai and played a crucial role in building industrial India.
- He served as Chairman of Tata Group and Tata Sons from 1991 to 2012 and as Interim Chairman from October 2016 to February 2017.
- The country has honored him with Padma Bhushan (2000) and Padma Vibhushan (2008).
- ▶ The cricket player who has achieved the record for the most Test runs scored by a cricketer for England Joe Root
- > A rare species of the damselfly belonging to the group of bambootails found in the vicinity of the Western Ghats
 - Agasthyamalai Bambootail (Agasthyamala Mulavalan)
 - The species was identified by a team of researchers from Iringalakuda Christ College.
- Place where Largest telescope of Asia located Ladakh
 - The telescope is located at an altitude of 4300 meters in Hanle, Ladakh.
 - It is indigenously built by Mumbai-based Bhabha **Atomic Research Center (BARC) with support from** Electronics Corporation of India Limited (ECIL) and other Indian industry partners.
