

SBI Clerk Syllabus 2025

SBI Clerk exam is conducted in two phases i.e., Preliminary and Main examination. Candidates must check SBI Clerk Preliminary Syllabus and SBI Clerk Mains Syllabus below.

SBI Clerk Preliminary Syllabus

SBI Clerk Preliminary Syllabus primarily tests candidates' skills in three areas: English Language, Numerical Ability, and Reasoning Ability. Below are the key topics for each section. SBI Clerk Exam Syllabus for English Language:

This section assesses candidates' proficiency in English and their ability to understand and interpret the language. The topics include:

- Reading Comprehension: Understanding the main idea, tone, and inferences from the passage.
- Sentence Error Detection: Identifying grammatical errors in sentences.
- Fill in the Blanks: Completing sentences with the appropriate words.
- Para Jumbles: Arranging jumbled sentences in a logical order.
- Cloze Test: Completing a passage with the most suitable words.
- Vocabulary: Antonyms, synonyms, and word usage.
- Spotting Errors: Identifying grammatical errors in a given set of sentences.

SBI Clerk Exam Syllabus for Numerical Ability:

This section evaluates candidates' mathematical abilities. The key topics include:

- Simplification and Approximation: Basic arithmetic operations and estimating values.
- Number Series: Identifying patterns and finding the next number in a sequence.
- Data Interpretation: Interpretation of data presented in tables, graphs, and charts.
- Speed and Distance: Questions related to time, distance, and speed.
- Percentages: Calculating percentages and their applications.
- Profit and Loss: Basic profit-loss calculations and applications.
- Averages: Understanding averages and their use in solving problems.
- Ratio and Proportion: Problems involving ratios, proportions, and variations.
- Simple and Compound Interest: Basic formulas and problems related to interest.
- Work and Time: Questions based on the work done by one or more individuals working together.

SBI Clerk Exam Syllabus for Reasoning Ability:

This section focuses on logical reasoning and problem-solving abilities. The important topics include:

- Blood Relations: Understanding relationships between family members.
- Coding-Decoding: Decoding or encoding information using different rules.
- Seating Arrangement: Arranging people or objects in a given order based on given conditions.



- Syllogism: Logical reasoning questions based on statements and conclusions.
- Direction Sense: Questions related to direction-based problems.
- Input-Output: Logical arrangements of data, numbers, or symbols.
- Ranking and Order: Arranging people or things according to ranks or positions.
- Data Sufficiency: Determining whether the given data is sufficient to answer a question.
- Puzzles: Solving complex puzzles with various constraints and conditions.

SBI Clerk Mains Syllabus

SBI Clerk Mains Syllabus is more comprehensive and covers a wider range of topics across four sections: General/Financial Awareness, General English, Quantitative Aptitude, and Reasoning Ability and Computer Aptitude.

SBI Bank Clerk Syllabus General/Financial Awareness:

This section focuses on candidates' knowledge of current affairs, financial knowledge, and general awareness. The key topics include:

- Current Affairs: Major national and international events, current affairs related to banking, sports, politics, economics, and business.
- Static GK: Knowledge of countries, capitals, currencies, important days, history, geography, etc.
- Economic and Financial Awareness: Banking terms, monetary policies, financial institutions, schemes, government policies, etc.
- Awards and Honors: Major awards and recognitions in the fields of sports, literature, etc.
- Books and Authors: Important books and their authors.
- Summits and Conferences: Key international and national conferences.

SBI Bank Clerk Syllabus General English:

This section tests candidates' proficiency in English language skills, including their understanding of grammar and vocabulary. The key topics are:

- Reading Comprehension: Passage-based questions to test understanding and interpretation.
- Cloze Test: Filling in the blanks of a passage with appropriate words.
- Para Jumbles: Rearranging the sentences in a paragraph.
- Sentence Correction: Identifying and correcting errors in a sentence.
- Synonyms and Antonyms: Questions related to word meanings.
- Fill in the Blanks: Completing sentences with appropriate words.

SBI Bank Clerk Syllabus Quantitative Aptitude:

The Quantitative Aptitude section assesses candidates' ability to solve mathematical problems. The important topics include:

- Data Interpretation: Interpretation of data presented in the form of tables, charts, and graphs.
- Mensuration: Problems related to area, volume, and perimeter of various shapes.



- Profit and Loss: Calculating profit, loss, and discount.
- Simple and Compound Interest: Calculating interest on amounts.
- Time and Work: Problems related to work efficiency and completion time.
- Time, Speed, and Distance: Questions on speed, time, and distance calculations.
- Probability: Basic probability and its applications.
- Permutations and Combinations: Arrangements and selections from a set of items.
- Ratio and Proportion: Ratios, proportions, and their applications.

SBI Bank Clerk Syllabus Reasoning Ability and Computer Aptitude:

This section tests both logical reasoning and basic computer knowledge. The key topics include:

- Logical Reasoning: Similar to the Prelims exam, including puzzles, seating arrangements, blood relations, and coding-decoding.
- Computer Aptitude: Basic knowledge of computer hardware, software, internet, operating systems, and applications.
- Data Sufficiency: Analyzing data to determine sufficiency for answering questions.
- Input-Output: Logical arrangements of data.
- Decision Making: Questions that test the ability to make decisions based on logical conditions.

SBI Clerk Prelims Exam Pattern 2025

SBI Clerk Prelims exam includes a total of 100 questions with 1 mark each. A total duration of 60 minutes is allotted to solve 100 questions from English Language, Numerical Ability, and Reasoning.
