SBI PO Mains Syllabus 2025

The mains exam holds a much deeper syllabus pattern than the prelims exam. As we have seen, the prelims exam is vast but comparatively easier than the main syllabus. But analyzing the mains syllabus, you will get an idea regarding the difficulty level enfolding in the mains syllabus. Likewise, the candidates can expect much tougher questions from the main syllabus. Thus, the preparation should be as per the expectation of the difficulty level.

1. Reasoning & Computer
2. English Language
3. Data Analysis & Interpretation
4. General Awareness
5. Descriptive Test (Letter Writing & Essay)

Interview Stage

The aggregate marks will be assigned to the candidates on qualifying of both the Objective Tests and Descriptive Test will be arranged in descending order in each category. An adequate number of candidates in each category, as decided by the Bank will be called for Group Exercises and Interview. The qualifying marks in Group Exercises & Interview will be as decided by the Bank. Candidates qualifying for Group Exercises & Interview under the 'OBC' category would be required to submit an OBC certificate containing the 'Non-Creamy layer' clause. Candidates not submitting the OBC certificate containing the 'Non Creamy layer' clause and requesting to be interviewed under the General category will not be entertained.
