



- The infusion is part of a restructuring and consolidation plan for IFCI.
- Government Stake Increase: As a result of the capital infusion, the government's holding in IFCI is expected to rise from the current 71.72% as of September 2024.

- Previous Capital Raise by IFCI:Earlier in the year, IFCI raised Rs 500 crore by issuing equity shares to the government.
- History and Purpose of IFCI:IFCI, established on July 1, 1948, is the first development financial institution in India. It was set up by the government to provide long-term finance for the industrial sector.






- Researchers at IIT Bombay, led by Prof. Viren Menezes from the Department of Aerospace Engineering, have developed a needle-free solution for drug delivery: the shock syringe.
- This breakthrough aims to make medical injections painless and more efficient, addressing common challenges associated with traditional needles.
- Technology: The shock syringe utilizes high-energy shock waves, traveling faster than the speed of sound, to deliver drugs without a needle.

- Micro Shock Tube System: Powered by pressurized nitrogen gas, the device generates a microjet of liquid that penetrates the skin at speeds twice as fast as a commercial airplane during takeoff.
- Size & Design: The shock syringe is about the size of a ballpoint pen, making it compact and easy to use.

6. With notable increases in both defense exports and domestic production, India reached a significant milestone in the defense sector during the fiscal year 2023–2024. Which year did Rajnath Singh set the goal of Rs 50,000 crore in defense exports?



- India achieved a major milestone in its defence sector during the fiscal year 2023-24, with significant growth in both defence exports and indigenous production.

- Total Value: Rs 21,083 crore (approx. USD 2.63 billion)
- Growth: A 32.5% increase compared to the previous year (Rs 15,920 crore in FY 2022-23).

• Long-Term Growth: Defence exports have increased by 31 times since FY 2013-14.

- Under the new system, applicants will be required to submit their visa applications exclusively through the official Thai e-Visa portal, thaievisa.go.th.
- For Indian travellers holding ordinary passports, the Embassy has assured that the existing 60-day visa exemption for tourism and

short business trips will remain in effect until further notice.



- The detection process revealed that 1 lakh to 1.5 lakh ghost beneficiaries were found in each district.
- The verification is still in progress, with the Aadhaar-based e-KYC process being conducted to bring transparency and improve the accuracy of beneficiary lists.

- Government's Measures: The Mohan Majhi government is working to eliminate ghost beneficiaries, a practice that allegedly persisted for the past 24 years.
- The government is also linking Aadhaar numbers with e-POS (Point of Sale) machines for better verification.



- Water Flow Control: The dam positions China to potentially regulate or divert the river's flow, affecting water availability in India and Bangladesh.


- Flood Risk: The dam could amplify risks of water release during hostile situations, creating security concerns for Indian border regions.
- Countermeasure Dam: India is constructing a dam on the Brahmaputra in Arunachal Pradesh to mitigate potential impacts of Chinese control.

- The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has granted an additional three years of time to the Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) to achieve 10% public shareholding.
- Under Rule 19(2)(b)(iv) of the Securities Contracts (Regulation) Rules, 1957, a company must have a 10% public shareholding in 5 years from the date of listing.
- Accordingly, with SEBI's extension, the revised timeline for the insurance corporation to achieve 10% public shareholding is on or before May 16, 2027.





- These labor codes aim to overhaul and modernize India's labor law framework, simplifying compliance and enhancing protection for


workers.

- As of December 28, 2024, all but five states and UTs have completed the pre-publication process for the draft rules.
- Regional Meetings: Between August and October 2024, six regional meetings were held to bring together stakeholders, address challenges, and accelerate the drafting and harmonization process of the rules.

- The events paid tribute to the victims, recognized the resilience of survivors, and reflected on two decades of rebuilding efforts.

- The PM CARES Fund, established in March 2020 to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic, witnessed a sharp decline in contributions in the financial year 2022-23.
- Donations fell significantly to Rs 912 crore, down from the record Rs 7,184 crore in 2020-21.
- Foreign Donations: Also surged to Rs 495 crore.
- 2021-22: Voluntary contributions dropped to Rs 1,938 crore, reflecting a decrease in the urgency as the pandemic situation eased.

- The total expenditure for 2022-23 was approximately Rs 439 crore.
- PM Cares for Children: Rs 346 crore was allocated to support children who lost their parents or guardians due to COVID-19.


- India's tech startups secured\$11.3 billion in funding in 2024, marking a recovery from the two-year 'funding winter.'

- Understanding Funding Winter: The term refers to a period of reduced investment due to various factors such as market instability, reduced investor confidence, or global economic conditions.
- 2024 Recovery: Reports confirmed that Indian startups raised \$11.3 billion in funding in 2024. This figure was publicly highlighted as a sign of recovery after the funding drought.



- Bank Empanelment Simplification: All RBI-listed agency banks are now included.
- Scheduled Commercial Banks with 0.2% of total EPFO collections are eligible, reduced from the previous 0.5% slab.







- Amity University's APEMS: Amity University, Mumbai, will launch spinach cells aboard ISRO's Spadex mission for the Amity Plant

Experimental Module in Space (APEMS) experiment.

- This aims to study how plant cells adapt to space conditions.
- Cowpea Experiment: ISRO will study the growth of eight cowpea seeds in space, from germination to the two-leaf stage.





- Definition of PAP: The Protected Area Permit (PAP) is required by foreign nationals to visit certain sensitive areas in India located near

international borders.

- These areas are deemed sensitive due to their proximity to international boundaries.
- Purpose of PAP:PAP ensures control over foreign nationals entering areas considered sensitive for security reasons.



- The state has introduced the Startup and Innovation Policy 2023, aimed at fostering a supportive environment for startups and encouraging business growth.
- StartupTN Mission Director and CEO Shivaraja Ramanathan.

- The market cap deadline for UPI apps has been extended by NPCI for a further two years, until 2026.
- The NPCI has given third-party Unified Payments Interface (UPI) apps an additional two years until December 31, 2026, to adopt a 30% volume cap.
- The NPCI has delayed the deadline for the third time.
- According to NPCI, the deadline for compliance for current thirdparty application providers (TPAPs) that exceed the volume cap has been extended by two years, or until December 2026.

- In November 2020, the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) first proposed capping the number of transactions that UPI apps could handle at 30%.
- The current players were given two years by NPCI to comply with the volume cap.
- Major TPAPs like PhonePe and Google Pay currently account for 80% of UPI transactions.

- The working group will revise the commodity basket of WPI and Producer Price Index (PPI) in light of structural changes in the economy.
- It will also review the current system of price collection and recommend changes for improvement.
- It will also decide on the computational methodology to be adopted by WPI or PPI.
- It will suggest improvement in compilation and presentation and recommend roadmap for switchover from WPI to PPI.
