- Indian woman to win the 2025 International Booker Prize Banu Mushtaq
 - The award is for Kannada writer Banu Mushtaq's collection of short stories 'Heart Lamp'.
 - Heart Lamp is the first short story collection to receive this honor.
 - The collection of short stories was translated into English by journalist Deepa Bhasthi.
 - Banu Mushtaq is the second Indian woman to win the International Booker Prize. The 2022 International Booker Prize was won by Hindi writer Geetanjali Shree for 'Tomb of Sand'.
 - Author who won the 2024 International Booker Prize -Jenny Erpenbeck (Novel - Kairos)
- Writer who was awarded the Madhavikutty Award for 2025 by the Punnayurkulam Sahitya Samithi Subhash Chandran
 - The award is for his comprehensive contribution to the field of Malayalam literature.
- ▶ The Artificial Intelligence (AI)-based anchor introduced by the Assam Government to disseminate important information from the Cabinet meeting Ankita
- ▶ Recipient of the first-ever Herman Gundert Prize of the Herman Gundert Education Foundation Vallikkavu Mohandas
