World Hepatitis Day

July 28

- 2025 Theme Hepatitis: Let's Break It Down
- The date of 28 July was chosen because it is the birthday of Nobel-prize winning scientist Dr Baruch Blumberg, who discovered hepatitis B virus (HBV) and developed a diagnostic test and vaccine for the virus.
- The first woman Vice-Chancellor of IGNOU Prof. Uma Kanjilal
- The place in Sri Lanka where a replica of the Ashoka Pillar was recently installed as part of cultural diplomacy and to recognize the contributions of Emperor Ashoka to Buddhism Waskaduwa
  - The replica of the Ashoka Pillar is installed at the Sri Subhuthi Viharaya in Waskaduwa.
- Kerala's project, which ranked first among 11 items under the State Collaborative Initiative implemented by the Department of Administrative Reforms of the Central Government

## **Digital Revenue Card Project**
