- Indian who has selected as mission pilot of Axiom-4 mission to the International Space Station - Shubhanshu Shukla

- → Air Force Group Commander Shubhanshu Shukla is the commander of ISRO's Gaganyaan mission.
- → Axiom-4 is a joint mission between NASA, ISRO and private company Axiom Space.
- → NASA's Peggy Wittson is the commander. The others are Tibor Kapu (Hungary) and Sławosz Uznanski-Wisniewski (Poland).
- NASA scientist and Indian-origin woman holds the record for the longest spacewalk by a woman - Sunita Williams
- The ship of the Indian Navy's all-women expedition team, that has crossed Point Nemo - INS Tarini
  - → Point Nemo is the furthest point from the Pacific Ocean.
  - → Point Nemo is known as the most remote place in the world and the graveyard of spacecraft.
  - → INSV Tarini is the ship of the Indian Navy's all-women expedition team that set out to circumnavigate the globe. The expedition is part of the Navika Sagar Parikrama II project aimed at women empowerment.
  - → The expedition began from Goa on October 2, 2024.
  - → The passengers on the ship are Lieutenant Commander Rupa and Lieutenant Commander Dilna, who is a Malayali.
- The country that successfully launched the navigation satellite
   Michibiki 6 on an H3 rocket in February 2025 Japan
- The country which has recently successfully completed an experiment in space to produce oxygen and rocket fuel through artificial light synthesis - China

- India's first flying taxi prototype Shunya
  - → The prototype was unveiled by aerospace startup Sarla Aviation.
  - → Shunya is designed to accommodate six passengers and carry a maximum payload of 680 kg.
- Mobile app which has been introduced by the Health
  Department to book OP tickets online in government hospitals
  as part of e-health, which effectively provides health services
  to the public MeHealth
- Vaccine developed in India to prevent lumpy skin disease, a serious disease affecting cattle - Biolumpi Vaxin
  - → The vaccine was developed by Biovet (Bengaluru), a Bharat Biotech Group company.
- The multi-barrel rocket launcher which is going to buy from India by France - Pinaka
  - → Pinaka is indigenously developed by India's Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO).
- The startup company which has built country's first 3D printed villa in Pune - Tvasta
- The world's longest subsea cable project which is announced by Meta to provide better connectivity to places like the US, India, Brazil, and South Africa - Project Waterworth
  - → The 50,000 km long subsea cable will connect five continents.
- India's fourth-generation submarine, which successfully completed wet testing in February 2025 - Matsya 6000

- → Matsya 6000 is an Indian crude deep-submergence vehicle under the Deep Sea Mission, intended for exploration of rare earth minerals in the deep sea.
- A mobile app launched by the Cooperative Department to sell agricultural products produced by cooperative banks and institutions under a unified brand - Angadi
- The latest chatbot introduced by Elon Musk-owned artificial intelligence company xAI - Grok 3
- A digital platform launched by SEBI to help investors track and recover dormant or unclaimed mutual fund folios - MITRA (Mutual Fund Investment Tracing and Retrieval Assistant)
- A new app launched by the Railways to provide all services related to Indian Railways to passengers in one place - SwaRail
  - → The app was developed by the Centre for Railway Information Systems (CRIS).
- The world's first quantum chip powered by a Topological Core architecture, introduced by Microsoft which aims to revolutionize quantum computing - Majorana 1
  - → Unlike traditional quantum chips that rely on electron-based qubits, Majorana 1 is built using a completely new type of material and particle, the Majorana particle.
- Drone developed by Kottayam IIT's Drone X Lab to deter elephants from entering human settlements from forest fringes - Astra V-1
- The social media platform which has introduced teen accounts in India for teenagers - Instagram
  - → Instagram teen accounts are designed to protect teenagers by limiting unwanted contacts and content.

- A scheme launched by the West Bengal government to develop riverine areas and create livelihood opportunities by connecting rivers and wetlands - Nodi Bandhan

  - → Key objectives of the scheme
