 - → He sang more than 16,000 songs in Malayalam, Tamil, Telugu, Kannada and Hindi languages.
 - → He was known as 'Bhaavagayakan'.
 - → He won the National Award for Best Singer in 1986 for the song 'Sivashankara Sarva Saranyavibho' from the film Sree Narayana Guru.
 - → He won the Kerala State Award for Best Singer in 1972, 1978, 2000, 2004, and 2015.
 - → He received the J.C. Daniel Award in 2020.
 - → He has won the Tamil Nadu State Film Award and the Kalaimamani Award from the Government of Tamil Nadu.

 - → This is a system that delivers extreme disaster warnings from the Central Meteorological Department,
 Geological Survey of India, Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services and Central Water
 Commission to all parts of the state. Extreme disaster warnings can be delivered to the public as messages as soon as they are received from the central nodal departments.
- The second forensic science lab in Kerala which has received ISO accreditation from the National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL) - Kannur Regional Forensic Science Lab

- → The Forensic Science Lab at the Thiruvananthapuram Police Headquarters is the first forensic science lab in Kerala to receive ISO accreditation.
- The constituency where the village court was established recently - Vamanapuram (Thiruvananthapuram)

 - → This robotic arm was developed at ISRO's Inertial Systems Unit (IISU) in Thiruvananthapuram.
 - → The robotic arm was developed to be used when India builds its own space station in the future.
- India's National Space Research Organisation which has sprouted cowpea seeds in space in January 2025 - ISRO
 - → Eight cowpea seeds, carried as part of the POEM-4 (PSLV Orbital Experiment Module) mission launched by PSLV-C60 rocket in January 2025, sprouted in zero gravity space within four days.
 - → The seeds were germinated using the Compact Research Module for Orbital Plant Studies or CROPS, one of the 24 experimental instruments on the 'POEM-4' mission.
 - → Developed by the Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre (VSSC), Thiruvananthapuram, CROPS is a system for studying seed germination and plant survival in microgravity.
 - → The CROPS project is envisioned to develop agricultural methods in interplanetary environments.

- Indigenously designed and built Fast Patrol Vessels delivered to the Indian Coast Guard by Goa Shipyard Limited (GSL) in January 2025 - Amulya and Akshay
- Portal designed by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) to streamline procedures for law enforcement agencies in India to seek international assistance through Interpol in criminal matters - Bharatpol
- Software which has been released by cybersecurity company McAfee to detect deepfake videos and audios using artificial intelligence - Deepfake Detector
- Revamped portal launched by the Central Government for eauction of all properties put up for auction by Public Sector Banks (PSBs) - BAANKNET
- Vehicle Which has been introduced by NASA as the successor to the Ingenuity helicopter for the extensive exploration of Mars
 Mars Chopper
 - → Ingenuity is a NASA helicopter that operated on Mars from 2021 to 2024 as part of the Mars 2020 mission.
- The anti-tank guided missile which was successfully tested by India in January 2025 - Nag Mark 2
 - → The test was conducted at the Pokhran Firing Range.
- Blue Origin's reusable heavy-lift launch vehicle successfully tested in January 2025 - New Glenn
 - → The test launch took place from Cape Canaveral Space Force Station in Florida.
 - → The 98-meter-tall New Glenn rocket can carry 45 metric tons of payload into low-Earth orbit.

- → The rocket was named New Glenn in honor of John Glenn, NASA's first astronaut to orbit the Earth.
- → The company Blue Origin is owned by Jeff Bezos.
- The warships which were commissioned by Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi at the Naval Dockyard in Mumbai in January 2025 - INS Nilgiri, INS Surat, and INS Vaghsheer
- The ship that was built and delivered to the Indian Navy by L&T Shipbuilding Limited in January 2025 - Utkarsh
- The space research organization that led India's first SpaDeX (Space Docking Experiment) mission - ISRO
 - → SpaDeX is a highly complex docking experiment mission that combines two artificial satellites in space.
 - → The SDX-01-Chaser and SDX-02-Target satellites of the SpaDeX mission were combined in space.
 - → ISRO launched two SpaDeX satellites on PSLV-C60 launch vehicle from Satish Dhawan Space Center in Sriharikota on December 30, 2024.
 - → India is the fourth country to have its own docking technology. The other countries are the United States, Russia, and China.
 - → Docking technology is essential for ISRO to build the Indian Space Station. In the future, the modules of the Indian Space Station should be launched in various phases and assembled in space through docking.
- Space Research Organisation which has successfully tested the restart capability of the Vikas Liquid Engine that powers the liquid stage in launch vehicles - ISRO

- → The test was conducted at the Engine Test Facility at the ISRO Propulsion Complex in Mahendragiri.
- Satellite launched by Pakistan in January 2025 PRSC-EO1
 - → The launch was made using a Long March-2D carrier rocket from China's Jiuquan Satellite Launch Center.
- A micro-missile system which was successfully tested by India recently, designed to counter enemy drones - Bhargavastra
 - → This micro-missile system was developed by Economic Explosives Limited.
- A Bengaluru-based start-up company that successfully launched three high-resolution hyperspectral satellites with the help of SpaceX - Pixxel
- The pulse diagnostic ayurvedic medical device which was indigenously developed by India - Nadi Tarangini
- Navigation satellite which has successfully launched by ISRO in January 2025 - NVS-02
 - → NVS-02 is ISRO's 100th launch.
 - → Launch vehicle GSLV F15
 - → NVS-02 was launched from the second launch pad at the Satish Dhawan Space Centre, Sriharikota.

 Rajagopala Chidambaram
 - → He played a crucial role in India's first nuclear test in 1974 and the Pokhran-II tests in 1998.
 - → He has also held many positions, including Director of the Bhabha Atomic Research Centre, Chairman of the Atomic Energy Commission, and Secretary to the Government.
 - → He has been honored by the country with honors including the Padma Shri in 1975 and the Padma Vibhushan in 1999.

 - → George Kumbanad is the cartoonist who created the famous cartoon character Uppayi Mapla.
