Shubhanshu Shukla

- Second Indian to go into space after Rakesh Sharma (1984) Shubhanshu
 Shukla
 - → Shubhanshu Shukla also became the first Indian to go to the International Space Station (ISS).
 - → Shubhanshu Shukla went into space as part of the Axiom-4 mission.
 - → Axiom-4 is a joint mission between NASA, ISRO, and private company Axiom Space.
 - → NASA astronauts Peggy Wittson, Tibor Kapu (Hungary), and Sławosz Uznanski-Wisniewski (Poland) are among the other astronauts on the Axiom-4 mission.
 - → The Axiom-4 mission was launched on June 25, 2025, aboard a SpaceX Falcon 9 rocket from NASA's Kennedy Space Center in Florida.
 - → On June 26, 2025, the Axiom-4 mission successfully docked with the International Space Station.

- The international police organization that issued the Silver Notice at the request of India - Interpol
 - → The Silver Notice is a color-coded notice introduced by Interpol in January 2025 to detect the movement of illegal assets around the world
- Miss World 2025 winner Opal Suchata Chuangsri (Thailand)
 - → 72nd Miss World pageant.
 - → Venue India
 - → India is hosting the Miss World pageant for the second consecutive year.

- → The entry ban is imposed on citizens of 12 countries: Afghanistan, Myanmar, Chad, Congo, Equatorial Guinea, Eritrea, Haiti, Iran, Libya, Somalia, Sudan, and Yemen.
- → Partial restrictions have also been imposed on citizens of Burundi, Cuba, Laos, Sierra Leone, Togo, Turkmenistan, and Venezuela.
- The name given to Israeli military attacks on Iran's secret facilities, including nuclear test facilities - Operation Rising Lion
 - → Iran's Islamic Revolution Guard Corps (IRGC) chief Major General Hossein Salami, Army Chief Mohammad Bagheri, and the head of the Revolutionary Guards' Khatam al-Anbiya headquarters, Major General Gholam Ali Rashid, were killed in the Israeli military attack.
- The ship, led by environmental activist Greta Thunberg, set off from the Italian port of Catania in June to deliver food and other aid to the suffering people in Gaza - Madleen
 - → The Israeli army intercepted the ship before it reached Gaza and detained 12 volunteers, including Greta Thunberg.
- Country that celebrates the Buddhist festival of Poson Poya Sri Lanka
 - → Poson Poya is an important Buddhist festival celebrated in Sri Lanka to mark the arrival of Buddhism to the island.
- The strait located between the Gulf of Oman and the Persian Gulf, which has been in the news amid the Iran-Israel conflict - The Strait of Hormuz
 - → The Strait of Hormuz is one of the most strategic waterways in the world.

 The only sea route to the Persian Gulf, this route carries 20 percent of the world's oil supply.

- The day chosen by the United Nations General Assembly to be observed every year as the International Day Against Unilateral Coercive Measures - December 04
- A new variant of Covid that has attracted attention due to its rapid spread in China and the US - NB.1.8.1
 - → This variant is also known as 'Nimbus'.
- The name given to the military operation launched by Iran in response to Israeli air strikes on its nuclear and command facilities in 2025 - Operation True
 Promise 3
- The US attack on Iran in June 2025 is known as Operation Midnight Hammer
 - → The US attacked Iran's nuclear facilities at Fordow, Natanz, and Isfahan.
 - → The attack used bunker buster bombs and Tomahawk missiles.
- According to the Global Liveability Index 2025 released by the Economist Intelligence Unit (EIU), the city with the best living conditions - Copenhagen
 - → Copenhagen topped the list based on several key factors, including healthcare, education, stability, infrastructure and environment.
 - → Copenhagen came in first place, overtaking Vienna, which had been at the top for the past three years.
 - → Vienna tied for second place with the Swiss city of Zurich.

• World's Tallest Railway Pier Bridge - Noney Bridge, Manipur

- → The construction of the bridge was completed on the Aling River in Noney district of Manipur.
- → The completed bridge, at a height of 141 meters, is the world's tallest railway pier bridge. The Noney Bridge has surpassed the record of the 139-meters Mala Rijeka Viaduct in Montenegro.
- → The bridge is 703 meters long.
- → The new bridge is part of the 111-km-long Jiribam Imphal railway line project, which aims to improve connectivity in the northeastern region.
- Place where country's first private helicopter manufacturing unit is established -Kolar, Karnataka
 - → The helicopter manufacturing unit is being set up under the Make in India project by Tata Advanced Systems and Airbus.
- First district in India to meet its entire electricity requirement through solar energy
 Diu
- Indian Navy women who circumnavigated the globe in a ship as part of Navika Sagar Parikrama II - K Dilna, A. Roopa
 - → Both set sail on October 2, 2024
 - → Ship INSV Tarini
- State that declared Harappan sites Mitathal and Tighrana as protected archaeological monuments - Haryana
- Place where The 'Mahila Samriddhi Yojana', a welfare scheme aimed at providing financial assistance of Rs 2,500 per month to poor women, was launched- Delhi

- The world's highest railway bridge The Chenab Bridge
 - → The Chenab Bridge is part of the Udhampur-Srinagar-Baramulla railway link project in Jammu and Kashmir.
- According to the data released by the National Statistical Office (NSO), India's
 GDP growth in the financial year 2024-25 6.5%
- Mock drills were conducted in border states to strengthen preparedness following the recent tensions between India and Pakistan - Operation Shield
- President of Paraguay who visited India in June 2025 Santiago Pena Palacios
- New frog species discovered in Shillong, Meghalaya Amolops Shillong
- The new name of Osmanabad Railway Station in Maharashtra Dharashiv Railway Station
- The system introduced by the Department of Posts to mark and locate addresses digitally, similar to the pin code used for postal transactions - Digital Postal Index Number (DIGIPIN)
 - → The DIGIPIN is a system that helps the Department of Posts deliver services to the addressee faster

- → This DIGIPIN can be used to locate a place much more accurately than the usual addresses.
- → This innovative system was developed by the Department of Posts and IIT Hyderabad.
- First Visually impaired woman lawyer to appear in a case before the Supreme Court - Anchal Bhateja
- Air India flight that crashed in Ahmedabad on June 12, 2025 Boeing 787
 Dreamliner Al 171
 - → The Air India flight, which took off from Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel Airport in Ahmedabad for London, crashed into the BJ Medical College Hostel building near the airport.
- Former Gujarat Chief Minister who died in the Ahmedabad plane crash Vijay
 Rupani
 - → He served as a Rajya Sabha MP representing Gujarat from 2006 to 2012 and as the Chief Minister of Gujarat from 2016 to 2021.
- State that declared 2025-35 as 'Decade of Hydropower' Arunachal Pradesh
- State that celebrates the Raja Parba festival, also known as Mithuna Sankranti -Odisha

- A new wildlife sanctuary came into existence in Tamil Nadu in June 2025 -Greater Flamingo Wildlife Sanctuary
 - → The Greater Flamingo Wildlife Sanctuary is located in Dhanushkodi in Ramanathapuram district.
- State that has raised the legal age for purchasing tobacco products from 18 to 21
 Karnataka
- The senior official who officially resigned as India's G20 Sherpa in June 2025-Amitabh Kant
 - → Amitabh Kant was the CEO of NITI Aayog for over six years from February 2016 to June 2022.
- New Motto of Lokpal Empower Citizens, Expose Corruption
- The temple where the first Indian epigraphic reference to Halley's Comet was found - Srisailam Mallikarjuna Swamy Temple, Andhra Pradesh
 - → This is a copper plate inscription made in 1456 CE during the Vijayanagara period.
 - → The discovery was announced by Dr. K. Munirathnam Reddy, Director of the Archaeological Survey of India.
- Operation launched by the Indian government to bring Indians safely to India amid Iran-Israel conflict - Operation Sindhu
- Place where Google's first security engineering center in the Asia-Pacific region and the world's fourth is established - Hyderabad

Indian woman selected as Astronaut Candidate (ASCAN) for future space
 missions by US-based private agency Titan Space Industries - Dangeti Jahnavi

KERALAM

- According to the Sample Registration System (SRS) report 2021 released by the Registrar General of India (RGI), The state which ranks first in the country in maternal and child protection - Keralam
- The Chairman of the Munambam Judicial Commission, who submitted the report regarding the legal protection of Munambam residents without eviction - Justice C N Ramachandran Nair
- Kerala's first extreme poverty-free municipality Shornur Municipality, Palakkad
- The agency Which is setting up a complaint box system in schools in the state in the new academic year with the aim of providing timely solutions to students' problems and ensuring a healthy environment in the school premises - Kerala Police
 - → Children can lodge complaints in the box set up by the School Protection Group (SPG) started under the leadership of the police in schools. The police will take action on the complaints in this box.
 - → An officer of the respective police station will be in charge of each school.

- The state which has been selected as the nodal state in the departmental summit held in Delhi in collaboration with NITI Aayog - Kerala
- The first extreme poverty-free district in Kerala Kannur
 - → The extreme poverty eradication project was launched in August 2021.
- A campaign launched by the Haritha Keralam Mission to plant one crore tree saplings in the state - Oru Thai Nadam
- The world's largest cargo ship arrived at Vizhinjam port in June 2025 MSC Irina
 - → Vizhinjam is the first port in the country to receive MSC Irina.
 - → MSC Irina, which is 399.9 meters long and 61.3 meters wide, can carry 24,346 TEUs (Twenty Foot Equivalent Units a TEU is considered a 20-foot container).
 - → Irina began operations in 2023
- The cargo ship that caught fire in the Kerala sea border between Beypore and Azhikkal - MV Wan Hai 503
 - → MV Wan Hai 503, which was sailing from Colombo to Mumbai, caught fire.
- An internet radio for children launched by the Kerala State Commission for Protection of Child Rights - Radio Nellikka
 - → The aim of Radio Nellika, an internet radio, is to create awareness on crucial issues such as the POCSO Act, Right to Education, Mental Health, Cyber Safety, tobacco products Abuse and Social Media Challenges among children.

- A campaign jointly organized by the Health Department and the Tribal
 Department to raise awareness about sickle cell disease Let's Know and
 Prevent Sickle Cell Disease campaign
- Candidate who has won the Nilambur by-election held in June 2025 Aryadan Shoukath
 - → The by-election was held after P. V. Anwar resigned as MLA in January 2025.

 - → The website keralatourism.org is at the second position in the global ranking. Thailand Tourism is at the first position.
- Winner of the Ministry of External Affairs Award for the Best Passport Office in India in 2025 - Kozhikode Regional Passport Office

 - → PSG won the title by defeating Inter Milan in the final.
- Venue of the 2026 ICC Women's T20 World Cup England
- Malayali athlete who won gold in 100m T47 category at 2025 World Para
 Athletics Grand Prix in Paris Muhammad Basil

- Title winner of 2025 UEFA Nations League Portugal
 - → Portugal won the title by defeating Spain in the final.
- The West Indies wicketkeeper-batsman who announced his retirement from international cricket in June 2025 - Nicholas Pooran
 - → Nicholas Pooran is the player who has played the most T20 matches for West Indies and the highest run scorer for West Indies in Twenty20 cricket.
- 2025 Norway Chess Champion Magnus Carlsen
 - → This is Magnus Carlsen's seventh Norway Chess Championship title.
 - → Fabiano Caruana finished second and India's D. Gukesh finished third.
- Former Indian captain who has inducted into the ICC Hall of Fame in 2025- MS Dhoni
 - → Dhoni is the 11th Indian cricketer to be inducted into the ICC Hall of Fame.
 - → Dhoni is one of the 7 new inductees into the Hall of Fame.
 - → Graeme Smith, Hashim Amla (South Africa), Daniel Vettori (New Zealand), Matthew Hayden (Australia), Sana Mir (Pakistan) and Sarah Taylor (England) are the other new inductees to the Hall of Fame.
- Title winner of 2023-25 ICC World Test Championship South Africa
 - → South Africa won the title by defeating Australia in the final held at Lord's Cricket Ground. London.
 - → Player of the final Aiden Markram
 - → South Africa captain Temba Bavuma

- Fielding move in cricket banned under Marylebone Cricket Club's revised rules in June 2025 - Bunny hop boundary catch
 - → A "bunny hop" boundary catch refers to a fielding technique in which a player jumps from outside the boundary, hits the ball in the air, and re-enters the field to complete the catch.
- Swedish pole vaulter who breaks his own record with a jump of 6.28 meters at the 2025 Stockholm Diamond League - Armand Duplantis
- Winner of the first edition of U-23 National 3x3 Basketball Championship in women category - Kerala
 - → Kerala won the title by defeating Karnataka in the final.
 - → Uttar Pradesh won the title by defeating Kerala in the men's category.
- Indian athlete who won the first place in the javelin throw at the 2025 Paris
 Diamond League Neeraj Chopra
 - → German athlete Julian Weber came in second place and Brazilian athlete Luiz Mauricio da Silva came in third place.
- The first Asian bowler to take 150 overseas wickets Jasprit Bumrah
 - → Jasprit Bumrah achieved historic feats in the Test match against England at the Headingley Cricket Ground in Leeds, England.
- Cricketer who holds the record for being the pace bowler with the most five-wicket hauls in the history of the World Test Championship (WTC) - Jasprit Bumrah
 - → His figures of 5/83 against England were Bumrah's 11th five-wicket haul in his WTC career.

- → With this, Bumrah surpassed the record of 10 five-wicket hauls held by Australian captain Pat Cummins.
- Malayali footballer selected for Indian senior women's football team for Asia Cup football qualification round - P. Malavika
- First Indian wicketkeeper to score a century in both innings of a Test Rishabh
 Pant
 - → Rishabh Pant achieved this feat in the Test against England.
 - → Rishabh Pant is the second wicketkeeper-batsman in world cricket to score two centuries in a Test. Former Zimbabwean player Andy Flower was the first to achieve this feat.
- Indian athlete who won first place in the javelin throw at the 2025 Golden Spike
 Athletics Championships held in Ostrava, Czech Republic Neeraj Chopra
 - → South Africa's Dow Smith came in second place and Granada's Anderson Peters came in third place.
- Indian hockey player who announced his retirement from international hockey in June 2025 - Lalit Kumar Upadhyay
 - → Lalit was a member of the Indian team that won the Olympic bronze medal twice. The Indian team that Lalit was part of won the bronze medal at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics and the 2024 Paris Olympics.
- The first Indian woman to score a century in all three formats of international cricket - Smriti Mandhana

LITERATURE

- The author of the book Andhaka Vallikal Sethu
- Writer who has been awarded the prestigious Dostoevsky Star Award from the Russian House in Mumbai in 2025 for his contributions to literature and cultural exchange - Javed Akhtar
 - → He was honoured for his outstanding contributions to literature, poetry, cinema and promotion of Indo-Russian cultural relations.
 - → Javed Akhtar became the first Indian writer to receive the Dostoevsky Star Award.
- India's most expensive literary award, which was discontinued in 2025 JCB
 Literary Award
 - → The award was given by the JCB Literature Foundation, which was established with the aim of promoting the art of literature in India.
 - → The annual literary award worth Rs 25 lakh was given to works of fiction written in English or written in Indian languages and translated into English.
 - → The present JCB Literary Director Mita Kapoor
 - → The first award was given in 2018. The award was last given in 2024.
 - → In 2018, the first JCB Literary Award was given to Malayalam writer

 Benyamin. Shahnaz Habib's English translation of the Malayalam novel

 'Mullappoo Niramulla Pakalukal' titled 'Jasmine Days' won the award.
 - → In 2019, the award was won by Madhuri Vijay's 'The Far Field' in Tamil.
 - → The award in 2020 was for S. Harish's Malayalam novel 'Meesha', translated by Jayashree Kalathil as 'Mustache'.
 - → The award in 2021 was for M Mukundan's 'Delhi Gathkal', translated by Fatima E.V. and Nandakumar K. as 'Delhi: A Soliloquy'.

- → In 2022, Khalid Javed's 'The Paradise of Food', translated from Urdu by Baran Farooqui, won the award.
- → In 2023, Perumal Murugan's 'Fire Bird', translated from Tamil by Janani Kannan, won the award.
- → The last award won (2024) was the book 'Lorenzo Searches for the Meaning of Life' by Upamanyu Chatterjee.
- → Translated works have won the prize five times out of the seven editions of the JCB Literary Award.

- Director General of Meteorology, India Meteorological Department (IMD), who has been awarded the 2025 United Nations Sasakawa Award for Disaster Risk Reduction - Dr. Mrutyunjay Mohapatra
 - → The award is for his contributions to the field of cyclones.
 - → Dr. Mrutyunjay Mohapatra, a native of Odisha, is known as India's Cyclone Man.
 - → The Sasakawa Award is given by the International Strategy for Disaster Reduction (ISDR), a specialized agency of the United Nations.
- Writer who won the Herman Gundert Education Foundation's first Herman Gundert Award - Dr. Vallikkavu Mohandas
- Malayali who received the highest British honor, the Commander of the Order of the British Empire, in June 2025 - Leena Nair
 - → Leena Nair is the Chief Executive Officer of French fashion brand Chanel.
 - → The award is given in recognition of outstanding contributions in the field of consumer goods.

- Indian Prime Minister who was awarded the Grand Cross of the Order of Makarios -III, Cyprus' highest civilian award, in June 2025 - Narendra Modi
 - → The award was given in recognition of his contribution to building India-Cyprus relations.
- First Indian lawyer to receive the 'Medal of Honour' given by the World Jurist Association (WJA) at the 2025 World Law Congress held in the Dominican Republic - Bhuwan Ribhu
- Writer who won the first IGF Archer Amish Storytellers Award at the India Global Forum 2025 in London - Shalini Mullick
 - → The award was given for Shalini Mullick's book 'The Way Home'.
- The recipient of the 2023 Television Lifetime Achievement Award instituted by the Kerala Government - K. Kunjikrishnan

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

- World's first indigenously developed ultra-high resolution weather model system -Bharat Forecasting System (BFS)
 - → The system was developed by the Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology, Pune.
 - → BFS is the world's highest resolution weather model system, using a 6 km x 6 km grid provided by India's supercomputer ARKA.
- The portal launched by the Ministry of AYUSH to protect AYUSH systems from misleading advertisements and to ensure that only safe and reliable products reach the people - AYUSH Suraksha Portal

- The probe launched by China to collect samples from near-Earth asteroid 469219 Kamo'oalewa - Tianwen-2
 - → The Tianwen-2 probe was launched from the Xichang Satellite Launch Center in southwest China using a Long March 3B carrier rocket.
- Indian Navy's first warship in the Anti-Submarine Warfare Shallow Water Craft (ASW-SWC) series - INS Arnala
 - → 'Arnala' is the first of the 16 ASW-SWC class ships to be inducted into the Indian Navy.
 - → INS Arnala was designed and built by Kolkata's Garden Reach
 Shipbuilders & Engineers (GRSE) in collaboration with L&T Shipbuilders
 in a public-private partnership.
 - → The warship is named after the historic Arnala Fort in Vasai, Maharashtra.
- The lunar mission of the Japanese private company iSpace, which crashed during a soft landing on the moon in June 2026 - Resilience
 - → Resilience was launched on January 15, 2025, aboard SpaceX's Falcon rocket.
 - → Tenacity is the rover that was part of the mission.
- A hybrid drone capable of vertical take-off and landing (VTOL) successfully tested by the Indian Army at the Pokhran Firing Range in Rajasthan in June 2025
 Rudrastra
 - → Rudrastra was developed by Nagpur-based Solar Defence and Aerospace Limited (SDAL) in collaboration with the Indian Army.

- The new air defense system introduced by Israel to counter missile threats -Barak Magen
 - → Barak Magen means "lightning shield" in Hebrew.
 - → It is designed to counter UAVs, cruise missiles, surface-to-sea missiles, and other aerial threats.
- The business jets which is decided to manufacture in India by France's Dassault Aviation in collaboration with Anil Ambani-owned Reliance Infrastructure - Falcon 2000
 - → This is the first time that Falcon 2000 jets are being manufactured outside of France.
 - → The production center for the aircraft will be set up in Nagpur.
