Groups- Concepts

- Sociological perspective, a group can be defined as two or more humans that interact with one another, accept expectations and obligations as members of the group, as well as share a common identity.
- Group may be defined as a collection of individuals who join together to achieve a goal.



Groups- Concepts

- The Oxford English Dictionary defines group as a number of persons or things regarded as forming a unit on account of any kind of mutual or common relation or classified together on account of a common degree of similarity.

PRIMARY GROUP

- The term first used by Charles Horton Cooley (C.H. Cooley) (1909) in his very famous book 'Social Organisation: Human Nature and Social Order'.
- It's a group, small number of persons come into direct contact with one another.
- They have mutual co-operation, companionship and sharing of personal feelings.
- Every person necessarily belongs to the any of the primary group



- For Cooley primary groups mean those characterized by intimate face-to-face association and co-operation
- Cooley considers family, playmates of children, neighborhood and community groups and groups of elders as primary groups.
- Primary association create we feeling among the group members
- It's a small number of people who interact intense, direct and personal manner.



Characteristics of Primary Group

Divided in to two - External and internal characters

External characters

- Physical proximity among group members
- Small size of the group
- Stability and durability
- Continuity in the relations



Internal characters

- Common objectives of the group
- The relations are ends in themselves
- Relationships are spontaneous
- Personal relationships
- Inclusive relations among members
- Control over the members
