Welcome to Odoo Hackathon!

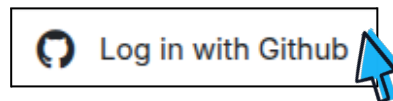
Once the team leader has initiated the team registration, team members along with team leader must follow the steps below to confirm their team participation and view their hackathon details.

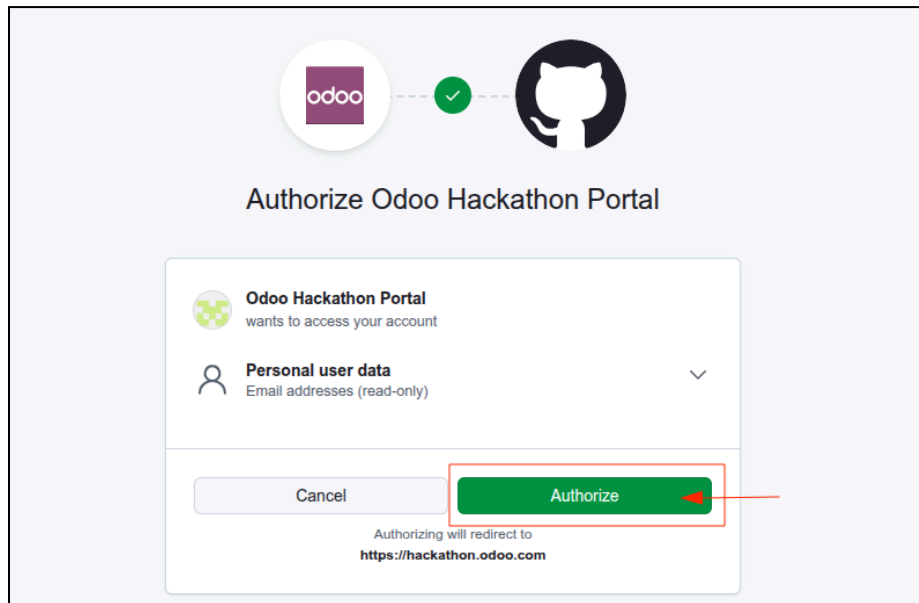
- Click on the option






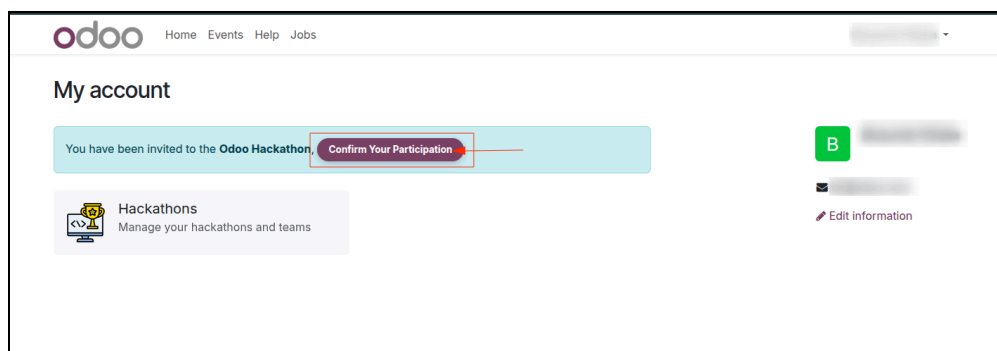
- Team members should login with the same Github id provided by the team leader while registering in the hackathon.


- Authorize the login if GitHub asks for permission.

- Click on **"Confirm Your Participation"** to open the form. 




- In the form, enter all the mandatory details – these fields are marked with an **asterisk (*)** beside them.
- After filling in the required information, click **“Save Address”**.

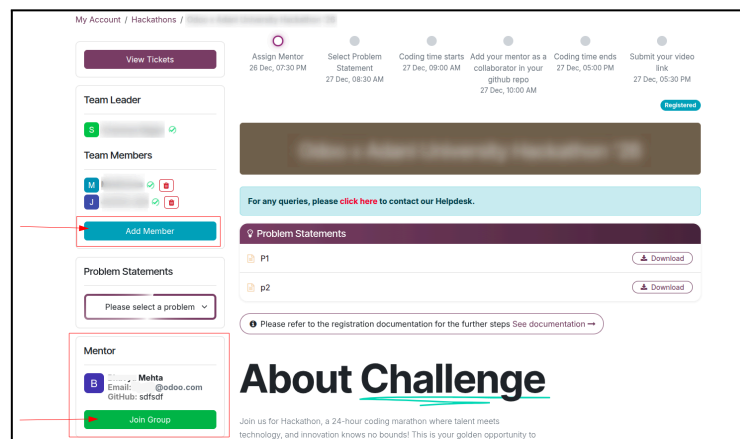

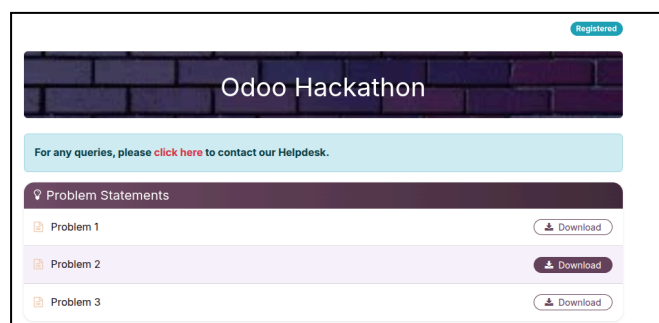
- Please follow the timeline strictly as shown in the **milestone section**.

- On the **Hackathon Details** page,

1. Only **Team Leader** can click on **"Add Member"** to add new members.
2. Team leader can also **delete** an existing member of they want.
3. The team can also view the Mentor assigned to them for the hackathon. Add **mentor's Github id** as **collaborator** in your repository. Please join the discord server by clicking on **Join Group** before the virtual round starts for real time updates.



- Once the problem statement (can be one or more than one based on the round) is **announced**, they will be visible to you on the details page. You can **download** the attached document to view the problem statement in detail.



- Only the **Team Leader** can select a problem statement from the **'Problem Statement'** dropdown. Once confirmed, it cannot be changed.

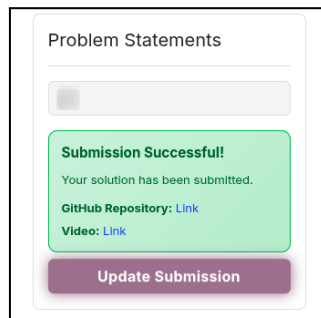

- The Team Leader can submit the team's solution video using the **"Submit Video Solution"** button.

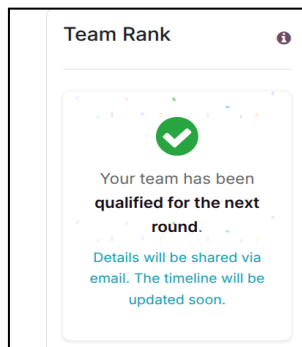
